ORDINANCE 1659

AN ORDINANCE TO ACCEPT THE APPLICATION FOR THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN TERRITORY CONTAINING 9.11 ACRES MORE OR LESS IN VAN BUREN TOWNSHIP TO THE VILLAGE OF LEIPSIC.

WHEREAS, a petition for annexation of certain territory in Van Buren Township was duly filed by Kenneth N. Boyer, agent for the owners of the above-mentioned territory; and

WHEREAS, the petition was duly considered by the Board of County Commissioners of Putnam County, Ohio on August 22, 1990, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has approved the annexation of the territory to the Village of Leipsic as hereinafter described by a resolution approved August 22, 1990; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners certified the transcript of the proceedings in connection with the annexation with the map and petition required in connection therewith to the Village of Leipsic's Clerk-Treasurer, who received same on August 28, 1990; and

WHEREAS, sixty days from the date of the filing with the Clerk-Treasurer have now elapsed in accordance with the provision of ORC 709.04.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Leipsic:

Section 1. That the proposed annexation as applied for in the petition of Kenneth N. Boyer and a majority of the owners of the real estate in the territory sought to be annexed and filed with the Board of County Commissioners of Putnam County, Ohio, on June 21, 1990, and which petition prayed for annexation to the Village of Leipsic, Ohio, of certain territory adjacent thereto as hereinafter described, and which petition was approved for annexation to the Village of Leipsic by the Board of County Commissioners on August 22, 1990, as follows:

Situated in the Township of Van Buren, County of Putnam and State of Ohio. The certified transcript of the proceedings for annexation with an accurate map of the territory, together with the petition for its annexation, and other papers relating to the proceedings thereto of the County Commissioners are all on file with the Clerk-Treasurer of the Villag of Leipsic and have been for more than sixty days.

Section 2. That the Village Clerk-Treasurer be and she is hereby authorized and directed to make three copies of this ordinance to each of which shall be attached a copy of the map accompanying the petition for annexation, a copy of the transcript of proceedings of the Board of County Commissioners relating thereto and a certificate as to the correctness thereof. The Clerk-Treasurer shall then forthwith deliver one copy to the County Auditor, one copy to the County Recorder and one copy to the Secretary of State and shall file notice of this annexation with the Board of Elections within thirty days after it becomes effective, and the Clerk shall do all other things required by law.
