ORDINANCE NO. 1679

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 1559 ESTABLISHING AN ACCESS RENTAL FEE TO BE CHARGED FOR WATER SERVICE FOR THE VILLAGE OF LEIPSIC'S WATER CUSTOMERS. SAID ORDINANCE IS ENUMERATED AS SECTION 51.14 OF THE BASIC CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF LEIPSIC.

WHEREAS, the Village now owns and operates a water supply distribution system, the services of which are to supply the users located both within and outside the corporate limits of the Village, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to meet the expenses of labor and equipment required to restore water service to Village customers,

WHEREAS, it is necessary that the persons requesting their water service be restored pay for this service.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Leipsic, Putnam County, Ohio, that:

Section 1. A rental access fee (water turn-on charge) of Twenty Dollars (\$25) shall be charged to restore water service to any Village customer where water services have been discontinued. any Village customer where water services have been discontinued. Said rental access fees require a twenty-four (24) hour advance payment of date the service is to begin. Any customer requesting either water access or discontinuance sooner than the twenty-four (24) hour advance time must pay an additional Ten Dollar (\$10) fee for either service or Twenty Dollars (\$20) for both. Said fee or fees will not be charged to discontinue or restore service when repairs are required to the water supply line from the curb stop (valve) to the point where the water supply line enters any structure. structure.

Section 2. Leipsic water customers with established good credit need not pay the access fees in advance. The Village will bill these individuals on their next monthly statement.

Section 3. There will not be an additional charge for new water service connections as the rental access fee shall be included in the water tap fee.

This Ordinance shall take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
