RESOLUTION 1734

A RESOLUTION REJECTING THE BIDS RECEIVED FOR THE LIBERTY STREET RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT AND AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO READVERTISE FOR SAID IMPROVEMENTS.

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the council of the Village of Leipsic, Putnam County, Ohio, that the bids received for the Liberty Street Reconstruction are below the grant amounts available for this project; and

WHEREAS, these additional grant funds should be used to make further improvements to Liberty Street; and

WHEREAS, to secure the best price possible for these additional improvements it is advisable to reject the present bids and readvertise the project with the additional improvements specified.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE Council of the Village of the Village of Leipsic, Putnam County, Ohio, that:

Section 1. The bids received May 27, 1992, for the Liberty Street Reconstruction Project be rejected.

Section 2. The village administrator is authorized to readvertise for bids for the Liberty Street Reconstruction after the specifications for the additional improvements are prepared by Poggemeyer Design Group, Inc.

This Resolution shall take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
