

Ordinance No. 1737Passed August 3 1992RESOLUTION 1737

A RESOLUTION DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO LEVY A TAX IN EXCESS OF THE TEN MILL LIMITATION.

WHEREAS, the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten mill limitation will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of said Village of Leipsic, Putnam County, Ohio.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Leipsic, Putnam County, Ohio, two-thirds of all members elected thereto concurring, that it is necessary to renew a tax levy in excess of the ten mill limitation for the benefit of the Village of Leipsic, Putnam County, Ohio for the purpose of current expense within the Village of Leipsic, Putnam County, at a rate not exceeding .60 mills for each one dollar of valuation which amounts to six (6) cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for the tax years 1993, 1994, 1995, 1996 and 1997 and which levy is a renewal of an existing levy of .6 mills; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that said levy be placed upon the tax list of the current year after the February settlement next succeeding the election, if a majority of the electors voting thereon vote in favor thereof; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Clerk of the Council of the Village of Leipsic be and she is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the Board of Elections, Putnam County, Ohio, seventy five days prior to the general election held November 3, 1992, and notify said Board of Elections to cause notice of election on the question of levying said tax to be given as required by law.

This Resolution shall take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

RESOLUTION 1736

A RESOLUTION BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LEIPSIC, PUTNAM COUNTY, OHIO, ACCEPTING THE BID OF WARD CONSTRUCTION TO RECONSTRUCT LIBERTY STREET WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE VILLAGE.

WHEREAS, The Village of Leipsic has been awarded an Issue II grant from the Ohio Public Works Commission to cover 90% of the costs of this reconstruction project, and

WHEREAS, It has been determined by the Council of the Village of Leipsic to be in the best of interest of the community to cooperate in this construction project, and

WHEREAS, The bids for this reconstruction project were opened and publicly read July 1, 1992.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Leipsic, Putnam County, Ohio, that:

Section 1. The village administrator be authorized to accept the bid of Ward Construction in the amount of \$77,703.75 as the lowest best bid received for the designed improvements to Liberty Street.

Section 2. The village administrator be also authorized to sign any change order mutually agreed to by the contractor, village engineer and the proper authorities of the Village of Leipsic.

This Resolution shall take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
