

Ordinance No. 1742Passed September 8 19 92RESOLUTION 1742

A RESOLUTION BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LEIPSIC, PUTNAM COUNTY, OHIO, REQUESTING THE PUTNAM COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TO ACCEPT THE BIDS OF UNDERGROUND PIPE AND VALVE FOR THE FURNISHING OF MATERIALS AND LEON RILEY EXCAVATING FOR THE PIPELINE BORING NEEDED TO CONSTRUCT A WATER MAIN TO DURALINE MEDICAL PRODUCTS.

WHEREAS, the Village of Leipsic, Putnam County, Ohio has been awarded a \$35,000 1991 CDBG Formula Grant for the construction of a waterline to the Duraline Medical Products building located at 324 Werner Street; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Leipsic has advertised, received and opened bids for the materials and work needed to construct this waterline improvement; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Leipsic desires that these materials and work be purchased with these CDBG Formula Funds; and

WHEREAS, these bids are awarded through the Putnam County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Council of the Village of Leipsic to be in the best interest of the community to construct this waterline.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Leipsic, Putnam County, Ohio, that:

Section 1. The Putnam County Commissioners be requested to accept the bid of Underground Pipe and Valve, Toledo, Ohio, for the furnishing of the materials needed to construct this waterline to Duraline Medical Products in the amount of \$18,410.80.

Section 2. The Putnam County Commissioners be requested to accept the bid of Leon Riley Excavating, Norwalk, Ohio, for the boring and casing pipe needed to construct this waterline under the Norfolk and Southern Railroad, in the amount of \$7,050.

Section 3. The Putnam County Commissioners be requested to accept the quote of \$9 per delivered ton for bedding gravel from Ward Materials and the quote of \$17.50 per square yard for pavement repair from Ward Construction.

This resolution shall take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
