RESOLUTION 1745

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO SUBMIT AN OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION GRANT APPLICATION TO THE PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION'S DISTRICT 13 INTEGRATING COMMITTEE FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO COMMERCIAL & CENTER STREETS.

WHEREAS, The Ohio Public Works Commission District 13 Integrating Committee is requesting grant applications for 1993 Financial Assistance; and

WHEREAS, The Village of Leipsic, Putnam County, Ohio, is eligible for the said financial assistance offered under the rules for Issue 2 funding of Section 164 of the ORC; and

WHEREAS, The Council of the Village of Leipsic has determined that it is in the best interest of the community to submit an application or applications to the said committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL of the Village of Leipsic, Putnam County, Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The Village Administrator is hereby authorized to submit an application or applications to the Ohio Public Works Commission District 13 Integrating Committee for a 1993 Issue 2 Grant for improvements to Commercial & Center Streets.

SECTION 2. The Village Administrator be authorized to make amendments to the said application or applications as deemed necessary to secure the said grant funds for the Village of Leipsic.

SECTION 3. The Village Administrator be authorized to sign the necessary documents needed to obtain the grant funding and execute a project agreement with The Ohio Public Works Commission.

This Resolution shall take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
