## RESOLUTION 1812

A RESOLUTION BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LEIPSIC, PUTNAM COUNTY, OHIO, ACCEPTING THE BID OF WARREN FIRE EQUIPMENT FOR A 1250 GPM PUMPER TYPE FIRETRUCK.

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Council of the Village of Leipsic with support of Fire District Committee that as the community has developed and grown, so has the need for increased fire protection; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Leipsic feels that it would be in the best interest of the community to meet current demands and prepare for future needs in the area of fire protection by upgrading its fire apparatus; and

WHEREAS, the Village opened bids for the pumper type firetruck and delivery deadline on December 9, 1993.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Leipsic, Putnam County, Ohio that:

Section 1. The Village Administrator be authorized to accept the bid of Warren Fire Equipment in the amount of \$171,460.00 as the lowest bid for the specified 1250 GPM Pumper Type Firetruck.

Section 2. The Village Administrator be also authorized to sign any change orders necessary to complete the construction and delivery of the 1250 GPM Pumper Type Firetruck.

This Resolution shall take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
