A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO SUBMIT A COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT APPLICATION TO THE PUTNAM COUNTY COMMISSIONS.

WHEREAS, the Putnam County Commissioners have funds available through the FY 1994 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program for dissemination to eligible communities; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners will be accepting applications to access these funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Leipsic, Putnam County, Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The Village Administrator is hereby authorized to submit an application to the County Commissioners for the formula CDBG Program.

SECTION 2. The Village Administrator be authorized to make amendments to the said application as deemed necessary to secure said grant funds for the Village of Leipsic.

SECTION 3. The Village Administrator be authorized to sign the necessary documents needed to obtain said grant funding.

This Resolution shall take effect from and after the earliest period allow by law.
