

Ordinance No. 1838Passed June 20 19 94RESOLUTION 1838

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO FILE AN APPLICATION AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES FOR THE PURPOSE OF ACQUIRING FUNDS THROUGH THE DIVISION OF FORESTRY'S URBAN FORESTRY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the quality of urban life is enhanced by the proper management of the urban forest resources; and

WHEREAS, the Leipsic Village Council recognizes the importance of providing tree and shrub related benefits to its citizens;

WHEREAS, funding for the purchase, installation and care of trees and other urban vegetation is available through the Ohio Department of Natural Resources, Division of Forestry.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LEIPSIC, COUNTY OF PUTNAM, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Village Administrator is hereby authorized to apply for and if awarded enter into agreement with the Department to administer a grant to implement said program, and that the Village Administrator is authorized to sign said agreement.

SECTION 2. That the Village Administrator hereby requests the Department of Natural Resources, Division of Forestry, to consider and fund its application project.

SECTION 3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
