

Ordinance No. 1939Passed Sept. 9 19 96RESOLUTION 1939**A RESOLUTION BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LEIPSIK, PUTNAM COUNTY, OHIO, ACCEPTING THE BIDS FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO THE MUNICIPAL WATER SYSTEM.**

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Leipsic is committed to make the necessary improvements to the municipal water system; and

WHEREAS, the said Council wishes to proceed with the implementation of these necessary improvements and expansion; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Leipsic has advertised for such improvements and expansion work; and

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of Poggemeyer Design Group that the Village Council accept the low bids for the various projects as the best bids.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Leipsic, Putnam County, Ohio, that:

Section 1. The Village of Leipsic accept the bid of \$248,458.50 from Johnson and Hughs for the raw water transmission line and well field development for the water plant improvements.

This Resolution shall be in effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
