ORDINANCE 1954

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE DEDICATION OF STREET RIGHTS-OF-WAY BY PRO-TEC COATING COMPANY WITHIN THEIR ADDITION TO THE VILLAGE OF LEIPSIC, PUTNAM COUNTY, OHIO.

WHEREAS, the PRO-TEC Coating Company Addition was annexed to the Village of Leipsic on August 10, 1990, and that since said time the addition has been under development for industrial use in accordance with the rules and laws of the Village of Leipsic; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best public interest to accept the plat with the dedicated areas for streets within the said addition; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Leipsic, Putnam County, Ohio has reviewed, discussed and considered the acceptance of this street dedication at their regular scheduled meeting open to the public.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Leipsic, Putnam County, Ohio.

Section 1. That the plat of the PRO-TEC Coating Company addition as prepared by Poggemeyer Design Group, Inc. be and the same is approved and accepted, and that the dedication to public use of the streets thereon shown, be, and the same is hereby accepted and confirmed.

Section 2. That the Mayor and Clerk-Treasurer of the Village of Leipsic be authorize to sign the said plat accepting the dedication of the said streets.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
