A RESOLUTION BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LEIPSIC, PUTNAM COUNTY, OHIO, ACCEPTING THE BID OF KIRK BROS. CONSTRUCTION, FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO THE LIME SILO WATER FLOW PIPE AT THE WATER TREATMENT PLANT.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Leipsic had discussed and approved the desirability of improving the piping system on the lime silo of the water plant; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Council of the Village of Leipsic at a regular scheduled meeting open to the public to be in the best interest of the community to proceed with this project; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Leipsic advertised for bids for the said improvements and said bids were opened and publicly read at 12:00 p.m. on May 6, 1998.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Leipsic, Putnam County, Ohio that:

Section 1. The Village Administrator be authorized to accept the base bid of Kirk Bros. Construction in the amount of \$23,800 as the lowest bid for the improvements to the lime silo water flow piping.

Section 2. The Village Administrator be also authorized to sign any other change order mutually agreed to by the contractor, Village Engineer and the proper authorities of the Village of Leipsic necessary to complete the said project.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
