A RESOLUTION BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LEIPSIC, PUTNAM COUNTY, OHIO, ACCEPTING THE BID OF WARD CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, INC. FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF PHASE II OF THE WATERLINE IMPROVEMENTS TO SERVE PRO-TEC COATING COMPANY'S DEVELOPMENT PROJECT, AND REQUESTING THE PUTNAM COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TO ACCEPT THE SAME SAID BID FOR THE RELEASE OF THE CDBG FUNDS AVAILABLE FOR THE SAID PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Village of Leipsic has been awarded a \$390,000 CDBG Development Grant through the Putnam County Commissioners to construct utility services to PRO-TEC Coating Company's development site; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Council of the Village of Leipsic to be in the best interest of the Community to complete this construction project; and

WHEREAS, the bids for the construction of this waterline project were requested in a joint advertisement and the said bids were opened and publicly read at 12:00 noon June 3, 1998;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Leipsic, Putnam County, Ohio that:

Section 1. The Village Administrator be authorized to accept the bid of Ward Construction Company of Leipsic, Ohio, in the amount of \$388,504.30 as the lowest best bid received for the construction of phase two of the industrial development waterline improvement project to serve PRO-TEC Coating Company.

Section 2. The Village Administrator be authorized to submit a copy of this resolution to the Putnam Count Commissioners with a recommendation that they accept the said bid for the use of the CDBG Development Grant funds awarded to the Village of Leipsic for this project.

Section 3. The Village Administrator be also authorized to sign any change order mutually agreed to by the Contractor, Village Engineer and the proper authorities of the Village of Leipsic.

Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
