A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CLERK-TREASURER OF THE VILLAGE OF LEIPSIC TO ENTER AN AGREEMENT WITH THE PUTNAM COUNTY CIC TO ACT AS THE VILLAGE'S AGENT FOR THE SALE OF DEVELOPMENT REAL ESTATE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Leipsic has designated the Putnam County Improvement Corporation as its agent for the industrial, commercial, distribution and research development of the said Village; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Leipsic, Putnam County, Ohio has discussed the possibility of selling certain real estate presently owned by the Village for commercial development in downtown Leipsic; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Council of the Village of Leipsic at a regular scheduled meeting open to the public to be in the best interest of the community and the prospective developer that the Putnam County CIC act as its agent for the sale of real estate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Leipsic, Putnam County, Ohio that:

Section 1. The Mayor and Clerk-Treasurer of the Village of Leipsic sign an agreement with the Putnam County CIC to act as its agent for the sale of real estate to the Fort Jennings State Bank.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
