RESOLUTION 2218

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR AND CLERK-TREASURER TO SIGN A MUTUAL FIRE PROTECTION CONTRACT WITH THE BLANCHARD TOWNSHIP, PUTNAM COUNTY, OHIO.

WHEREAS, it would be mutually beneficial for the Village of Leipsic, Putnam County, Ohio, and the Blanchard Township, Putnam County, Ohio, to enter into a mutual aid fire contract for additional fire protection for each of said respective parties, and

WHEREAS, each of said parties is prepared to furnish to the other such additional fire protection as may be required of the other.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Leipsic, Putnam County, Ohio that:

Section 1. The Mayor and Clerk-Treasurer are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a mutual aid agreement for additional fire protection services with the Blanchard Township, Putnam County, Ohio.

Section 2. There shall be no charge for such mutual fire protection.

This Resolution shall take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
