

Ordinance No. 2225Passed March 17, 2003RESOLUTION 2225

A RESOLUTION BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LEIPSIC AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO FILE AN APPLICATION AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES FOR THE PURPOSE OF ACQUIRING FUNDS THROUGH THE DIVISION OF FORESTRY'S URBAN FORESTRY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the quality of urban life is enhanced by the proper management of the urban forest resource; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Leipsic recognizes the importance of providing tree and shrub related benefits to its citizens; and

WHEREAS, funding for the purchase, installation, and care of trees and other urban vegetation is available through the Ohio Department of Natural Resources, Division of Forestry.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Leipsic, Putnam County, Ohio that:

Section 1. That the Village Administrator is hereby authorized to apply for and, if awarded, enter into an agreement with the Department to administer a grant to implement said program, and that the Village Administrator is authorized to sign said agreement.

Section 2. That the Village of Leipsic hereby requests the Department of Natural Resources, Division of Forestry, to consider and fund its application project.

Section 3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Village Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting this 17th day of March, 2003, and that all deliberations of the Village Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
