#RESOLUTION 2229

A RESOLUTION BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LEIPSIC, PUTNAM COUNTY, OHIO, ACCEPTING THE BID OF ALL PURPOSE CONTRACTING, INC. FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A GRAVITY SANITARY SEWER TO SERVE BROADWAY STREET, AND REQUESTING THE PUTNAM COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TO ACCEPT THE BID FOR THE RELEASE OF THE CDBG FUNDS AVAILABLE FOR THE SAID PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Village of Leipsic has been awarded a \$21,500 CDBG Formula Grant through the Putnam County Commissioners to construct a sanitary sewer extension for Broadway Street; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Council of the Village of Leipsic to be in the best interest of the Community to complete this construction project; and

WHEREAS, the bids for this construction project were requested in a joint advertisement and the said bids were opened and publicly read at 11:00 a.m. April 30, 2003.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Leipsic, Putnam County, Ohio that:

Section 1. The Village Administrator be authorized to accept the bid of All Purpose Contracting, Inc. of Delphos, Ohio, in the amount of \$99,659.00 as the lowest best bid received for the Construction of this sanitary sewer project.

Section 2. The Village Administrator be authorized to submit a copy of this resolution to the Putnam County Commissioners with a recommendation that they accept the said bid for the use of the CDBG Formula grant funds awarded to the Village for this project.

Section 3. The Village Administrator be also authorized to sign any change order mutually agreed to by the Contractor, Village Engineer, and the proper authorities of the Village of Leipsic.

Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
