ORDINANCE 2310

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCES 989 AND 1478 OF THE VILLAGE OF LEIPSIC REQUIRING ALL USERS OF SEWER SERVICES TO HAVE SEPTIC TANKS.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency is requiring the Village of Leipsic establish a plan and schedule to separate its sanitary system from storm water infiltration; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Leipsic is planning to construct this separated sewer system as required under Ohio Environmental Protection Agency regulations in the near future; and

WHEREAS, with this said plan in place the Village of Leipsic may remove the regulations that require septic tanks within the Village; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Council of the Village of Leipsic at a regular scheduled meeting open to the public to be in the best interest of the community that this said requirement to have septic tanks on all residential properties be amended.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Leipsic, Putnam County, Ohio that:

Section 1. That Village of Leipsic Ordinances 989 and 1478 requiring septic tanks be installed within the Village be amended and repealed eliminating the said requirement.

Section 2. That all new sewer taps within the Village of Leipsic shall be charged a fee of \$1100.00 or any future amended rate as established by Council.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
