

Ordinance No. 2311Passed 1-3, 2005RESOLUTION 2311

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN AN AGREEMENT FOR THE PURCHASE OF 17.33 PLUS OR MINUS ACRES OF REAL ESTATE LOCATED IN SECTION 20 OF VAN BUREN TOWNSHIP AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Leipsic desires to promote industrial, commercial, distribution and research development of the said Village; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Leipsic is interested in developing a future water supply to serve these potential developments; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Leipsic has discussed the possibility of purchasing additional real estate adjacent to real estate presently planned for development as an industrial park; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Council of the Village of Leipsic at a regular meeting open to the public to be in the best interest of the community to purchase this said real estate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Leipsic, Putnam County, Ohio that:

Section 1. The Village Solicitor be authorized to prepare the documents necessary for the purchase of the said 17.33 plus or minus acres located in Section 20 of Van Buren Township, Putnam County, Ohio.

Section 2. The Mayor and Fiscal Officer be authorized to sign all documents necessary to complete the purchase of this said real estate.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
