

Ordinance No. 2317Passed 3.7, 2005RESOLUTION 2317**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE IAMS COMPANY TO PLACE TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNS ON ROAD 5 AND STATE ROUTE 65.**

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Leipsic, Putnam County, Ohio, has discussed the proposed placement of traffic control sign within the public right-of-way of Road 5 and State Route 65 within the heavy industrial areas of the community; and

WHEREAS, it was determined to be in the best interest of the public that proper signage be placed in the industrial area to direct the truck traffic; and

WHEREAS, the said Council has reviewed this matter at their regular meeting which is open to the public.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Leipsic, Putnam County, Ohio that:

Section 1. The Iams Company be authorized to place traffic control signage within the right-of-way of Road 5 and State Route 65 within the Village of Leipsic provided the said signs conform to the Ohio Department of Transportation standards for this type of signs to be located on a Village street in an industrial area.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
