

RESOLUTION 2400

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE INTENTION TO VACATE A PART OF VILLAGE OF LEIPSIC ROAD D-5 WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF LEIPSIC, PUTNAM COUNTY, OHIO.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Leipsic, Putnam County, Ohio is in the process of developing the Iron Highway Industrial Park located in Section 20 of Van Buren Township; and

WHEREAS, as part of this development it would be advantageous to vacate a portion of Road D-5 located within the Village of Leipsic and the Iron Highway Industrial Park; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Council of the Village of Leipsic at a regular scheduled meeting open to the public to be in the best interest of the community and the prospective development of the said Iron Highway Industrial Park area if a portion of Road D-5 was vacated.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Leipsic, Putnam County, Ohio that:

Section 1. It is the intention of the Village of Leipsic to vacate Road D-5 from the west boundary of the abandoned Cincinnati and Lake Erie Railroad, now owned by the Village of Leipsic, west until the west boundary of east half of the west half of the northwest quarter Section 20 Van Buren Township, Putnam County, Ohio. Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

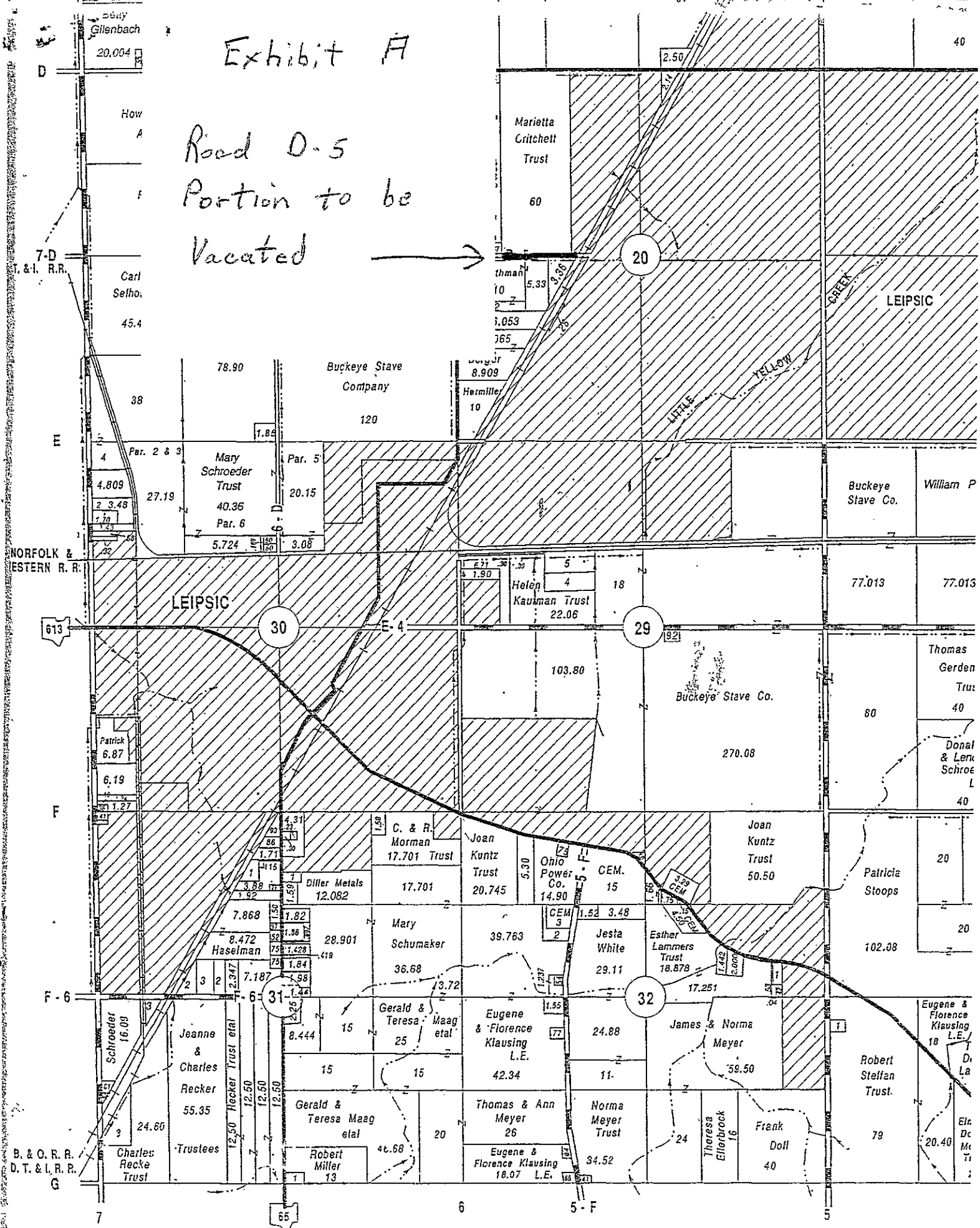


Exhibit A
