ORDINANCE 2408

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO FILE AN APPLICATION WITH THE STATE OF OHIO, TO PARTICIPATE IN THE SMALL CITIES COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT WATER AND SEWER COMPETITIVE GRANT PROGRAM AND DECLARING THIS ACT AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Leipsic desires to participate in the Program to receive financial assistance for water improvements under the Small Cities Community Development Block Grant Water and Sewer Competitive Grant Program (hereinafter referred to as the "Program"); and

WHEREAS, the Village of Leipsic has the authority to apply for financial assistance and to administer the amounts received from the State of Ohio, Department of Development, through its Program; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Leipsic must direct and authorize the Administrator to act in connection with the application and to provide such additional information as may be required.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Leipsic, a two-thirds (2/3) majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That Council authorizes the Administrator as the official representative of the Village of Leipsic to participate in the Program, and provide all information and documentation required in said Application for submission.

Section 2. That the Council of the Village of Leipsic hereby approves filing an application for financial assistance under the Program.

Section 3. That the Council of the Village of Leipsic hereby understands and agrees that participation in the Program will require compliance with Program guidelines and assurances.

Section 4. That the Council of the Village of Leipsic hereby commits to provide the local share funding as identified in the Application.

Section 5. That Council hereby finds that all actions taken relative to the consideration and adoption of this Ordinance were in full compliance with law, including the applicable law relating to "open meetings".

Section 6. That this Ordinance is deemed and declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, and for the prompt processing of the Application, and shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
