RESOLUTION 2488

A RESOLUTION BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LEIPSIC NAMING THE PARK AREA LOCATED AT THE SOUTH END OF STATE STREET CHARLIE H. BENNETT PARK.

WHEREAS, Charlie H. Bennett has dedicated his life to this community, and has demonstrated in many practical ways his deep and genuine love for Leipsic and the surrounding area; and

WHEREAS, he has served the community with distinction in the long list of athletic programs in which he participated, demonstrating his willingness to place his concern for the youth of this community ahead of his personal interests; and

WHEREAS, he has earned the admiration and high regard of those with whom he has come into contact, and the affection of the coaches, players and fans of all the events in which he participated, who are proud to call him "friend"; and

WHEREAS, his sphere of influence and activity has extended beyond the playing field into various community programs, and in every case making a definite contribution to the development of the Leipsic community; and

WHEREAS, on behalf of the entire Village Council and the citizens of Leipsic, we wish to extend to Charlie H. Bennett this public recognition and deep appreciation for his distinguished service to the youth of this community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Leipsic, Putnam County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the 57 acre Park and Sports Complex located at the south end of State Street be named the Charlie H. Bennett Park.

Section 2. That this resolution shall take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
