RESOLUTION 2494

A RESOLUTION BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LEIPSIC ACCEPTING THE BID OF DEGEN EXCAVATING COMPANY, INC. FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF PHASE II OF THE COMBINED SEWER SEPERATION PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency has mandated that the Village of Leipsic separate its combined sewer system; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Leipsic has determined that it is in the best interest of the community to eliminate the disruption to the Village that a ten year construction project would cause and decided to complete the entire Village in two projects; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Leipsic did advertise for bids to construct Phase II of the said combined sewer separation project and the said bids were publicly opened at 12:00 Noon on March 26, 2008; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Leipsic has reviewed and discussed the bid tab, the timing of its loan and grant application for the project and the recommendation of Poggemeyer Design Group, Inc. for the construction of the said combined sewer separation project at a special meeting, open to the public, and has determined it to be in the best interest of the Village to accept the lowest bid as the best bid for this project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Leipsic, Putnam County, Ohio that:

Section 1. The bid of Degen Excavating Co., Inc. in the amount of \$755,503.47 to construct Phase II of the Village of Leipsic's combined sewer separation project be accepted contingent upon the Village receiving an OEPA-DEFA 0% interest loan for the remainder of the construction costs.

Section 2. The Village Administrator be authorized to sign a contract and any properly approved change order needed to complete the said construction project.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
