ORDINANCE 2951

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF A SCRAPER THAT IS UNNEEDED FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSES AND DETERMINING THAT THIS SALE WILL NOT BE DETRIMENTAL TO THE GENERAL INTEREST OF THE VILLAGE OF LEIPSIC, PUTNAM COUNTY, OHIO.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Leipsic has determined a need to sell a scraper, commonly referred to as a pan, which is no longer needed for municipal purposes; and

WHEREAS, the value of this equipment is in excess of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.); and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Revised Code 721.15 requires such a sale to advertised in a newspaper of general circulation in the municipal corporation for not less than two consecutive weeks, and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Council of the Village of Leipsic at a regular public meeting, open to the public that it is in the best interest of the Village to sell this equipment through the internet auction method.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Leipsic, Putnam County, Ohio that:

Section 1. The Village Administrator is hereby authorized to dispose of a scraper commonly referred to as a pan.

Section 2. That the Village Administrator be authorized to sell said equipment that has been declared as surplus property through the use of internet auction. Notice of said auction to the highest bidder will be published at least twice in a newspaper of general circulation, including a description as to how the auction will be conducted, the item to be sold, the conditions of the sale, and the specific number of days for bidding on the property, which shall be no less than ten (10) calendar days, including Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holidays.

Section 3. The auction will be conducted using a third-party contractor, namely:

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor at the earliest period allowed by law.
