RESOLUTION 3442

A RESOLUTION BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LEIPSIC, PUTNAM COUNTY, OHIO ACCEPTING THE BID OF WARD CONSTRUCTION COMPANY FOR STREET RESURFACING IMPROVEMENTS, WITHIN THE VILLAGE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Leipsic has determined the need to resurface several streets, and

WHEREAS, the Village did advertise for bids for this construction, with the said bids opened and publicly read on June 17, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the Leipsic Village Council has reviewed and discussed the bid tab and recommendation of Bockrath & Associates for completion of this said construction at a regular meeting, open to the public, and has determined it to be in the best interest and safety of the citizens of the Village of Leipsic to accept the lowest as the best bid for this construction; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council and any of its Committees concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council or Committees, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its Committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Leipsic, Putnam County, Ohio that:

Section 1. The Village Administrator be authorized to accept the best base bid from Ward Construction Company in the total amount of \$83,251.00.00. Also, alternate Bid #1 in the amount of \$36,675.00 and alternate Bid #2 in the amount of \$77,600.00 for a total contract award recommendation of \$197,526.00 for the 2025 Village of Leipsic's Street Improvement Project (OPWC Round 39).

Section 2. The Village Administrator be authorized to sign a contract and any properly approved change orders needed to complete the said needed construction.

Section 3. This resolution shall be declared an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare.
