ORDINANCE NO. 3452

AN ORDINANCE: OF THE VILLAGE OF LEIPSIC, OHIO REGARDING IMPROPER DUMPING ON VILLAGE PROPERTY

Whereas, the Council of the Village of Leipsic, Ohio met at a duly called and authorized meeting of the Council, such meeting being duly called pursuant to the rules of Council, with notice received by all Council members.

Whereas, it is desirable for the Village of Leipsic, Ohio to preserve the usual daily operating necessary to the citizens. Further, it is necessary to establish boundaries on improper dumping on Village property, including at the Village compost site.

Whereas, the Council of the Village of Leipsic, by an affirmative vote of the majority of the members elected, approved Ordinance # 3452 read by title on three different days as proscribed by law.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LEIPSIC, OHIO, BY A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING:

Section 1. That the only materials permitted to be dumped on Village property, shall be permitted to be dumped at the Village compost site. Such materials shall be limited to grass clippings, brush, tree branches, and bushes. No party shall be permitted to deposit trunks of trees at such compost site. Any branches shall be 10 inches or less in diameter.

Section 2. That no dumping of plywood, processed lumber, construction materials, household waste, or materials other than outlined in Section 1 herein is permitted to be dumped on any Village property.

Section 3. That any violation of this matter shall be considered littering enforceable by the terms of the Ohio Revised Code and Village Code.

Section 4. That the Council of the Village of Leipsic, Ohio hereby finds that all discussion and debate regarding the matter was conducted in open session of council pursuant to the provisions of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 5. That the Council of the Village of Leipsic, Ohio authorizes the Fiscal Officer to make publication and approval from the earliest period prescribed by law.
