Ordinance No. _____ RESOLUTION 3467 ^{Passed} _____, 20____

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE TAX INCENTIVE REVIEW COUNCIL AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, under Ohio Revised Code Section 3735.65 through 3735.70 has authorized municipalities with the consent of The State of Ohio, to designate areas as Community Reinvestment Areas and to execute agreements with certain enterprises for the purpose of establishing, expanding, renovating or occupying facilities and hiring new employees and preserving jobs within said areas in exchange for specified local tax incentives granted by the municipality; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Leipsic by Resolution 2582 dated June 15, 2009 designated as Community Reinvestment Areas pursuant to Section 3735.66 of the Ohio Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Leipsic was notified of the recommendations from the most recent compliance review of the Tax Incentive Review Council (TIRC) for CRA Area #137-42602-01 and #137-42602-02; and adopted this appointment at a regular meeting open to the public, and

WHEREAS, the recommendations were as follows: to continue with CRA Agreements 08-001 (The Kahle Company), 09-001 (Proctor & Gamble-The Iams Company), 10-001 (The Iams Company), 10-002 (Pro-Tee Coating Company, Inc.), 11-002 (Putnam Enterprises, LLC), 12-001 (Patrick Products Inc./Patrick Holdings Inc.) PRO-TEC Coating Company 1/5/2018 and Ward Construction Company 2018. To agree that the Tax Increment Financing Agreements with Poet Biorefining created 05/21/2007, The Iams Company created 07/23/2009, The Iams Company created 06/07/2010, Pro-Tee Coating Company created 12/31/2010, and PRO-TEC Coating Company 1/5/2018 are in compliance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Village of Leipsic, Putnam County, Ohio accepts the recommendations of the Tax Incentive Review Council for its annual review for 2026.

Section 1. This Resolution shall take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law. THAT this Resolution shall be declared an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, safety, and welfare, this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the mayor at the earliest period allowed by law.
