
MAKE AN IMPACT:



BFAIR hosts a Brain Injury Awareness Campaign during the months of March and April to promote education and awareness of Acquired Brain Injuries (ABI). Utilizing the theme set by the Brain Injury Association, we also aim to share and uplift stories of brain injury survivors. Each year, we distribute bicycle helmets across Berkshire County and in the Pioneer Valley as part of this campaign.
