Diane's dedication to arts education and infrastructure also transformed the Whidbey Island Fairgrounds, including the development of the Pottery Shack and the refitting of the Pole Building, personally contributing labor and materials to create spaces for the professional display of photography and fine arts exhibits.

Under Diane's leadership, the Fair developed an enhanced focus on Primary and Junior Arts & Crafts. She also instigated the introduction of art and crafts raffle baskets. At the new Pottery Shack, the Fair offered youngsters an opportunity to learn how to work with clay. Diane also brought the beloved Scarecrow Contest to our Fair, which continues to be a popular family event.

Diane's tenure as president of the Fair Association was marked by grace and fortitude through many years and many trials. Her smart, inquisitive nature and her ability to think both critically and intuitively have been invaluable. Diane colors outside the lines, viewing chaos with a refreshing calm that is soothing to those around her.

Diane's companionship at the annual State Fairs Convention and various superintendent or manager meetings across the state has been delightful. Her brilliant conversational skills made the miles melt away, and her ability to hurkle-durkle, a term meaning to linger in bed, added a touch of humor to our travels.

Diane's unwavering commitment to the arts has fostered creativity, community, and cultural vitality across Whidbey Island. Her extraordinary passion for the arts, as exemplified by her service, vision, and generosity will continue to benefit the Whidbey Island Fair for many years to come.

FAIR ASSOCIATION HISTORY

Roots of the Island County Fair go back to 1912, when it was established in Coupeville by a private company known as the Island County Fair Association. But the fair needed to draw its audience from all of Whidbey Island, and for South Whidbey residents back then, the trip to Coupeville was difficult and expensive. Traveling by horseback or carriage, it was a 20- to 30- mile journey, which necessitated an overnight stay. Excursion boats brought passengers from Camano Island and various points on Whidbey Island, but the fair attendance remained poor and the fair died out in 1916 for lack of support.

Langley resurrected the fair in 1917 on the town's waterfront. In 1922, it was moved to the town's school gymnasium, and the following year the fair was organized as a nonprofit organization funded by memberships. By the late 1920's, there were better roads and auto travel. The fair prospered and in 1934 - one of the worst years of the Great Depression - the Fair Association built the pole building on property adjacent to the school. Using support from the WPA (Works Progress Administration), the Association purchased a six-acre chicken ranch near the school and construction began on a large fair building, completed in 1937. During the next three decades horse barns and exhibit halls were added.

The Association continues to operate the Fair annually. In 2015 the Port of South Whidbey acquired the property from Island County and continues to work with the ICFA to maintain the property and support The Whidbey Island Fair.
