#### MARION COUNTY QUORUM COURT MINUTES

January 9, 2024

The Marion County Quorum Court held their monthly meeting beginning at 6 p.m. on January 9, 2024.

Judge Stumph presided over the meeting and all Justices were present with the exception of Justice Scrima. Karen Carter gave the invocation and Dawn Moffet led the Pledge.

The December minutes were approved.

The Treasurer's report and the Sheriff's report were verbally given. During the Law Enforcement reports Sheriff Alexander commented that the new vehicles had not been delivered yet, but hoped to have them within a week.

#### Old Business:

Justice White commented on the Library Director's pay. He stated that although the Library has their own funds, the Quorum Court is directly responsible for setting the pay scales in the various offices. He stated that according to the Library Law book the salaries are decided by the Quorum Court. He continued that the Library salaries are not any more special than any other office. He encouraged everyone to listen to the Library meeting audios. He stated that these were public meetings and that many things were said about the Quorum Court after the Quorum Court members had left the meetings. He commented that he had actually gotten an invitation to the meeting. He continued that the harassment and misconceptions had to stop. That comments made on the audios regarding that the Quorum Court wanted the Library's money was false. Also, the comment that the Director made regarding having to work overtime would be difficult to do, as she only works four days a week.

#### New Business:

Justice Vancuren made a motion to read the ordinance by title only, Justice Nickels seconded it and the motion passed unanimously.

Ordinance 2024-1 – Election Reimbursement – Sponsored by the Budget Committee. This ordinance appropriates \$95.68 from County General to the Election travel line item. The motion to adopt was made by Justice Reed and seconded by Justice Vancuren. The motion passed unanimously.



Judge Stumph appointed Michael Haynes, Paul Hudson and Bob Zdora to the Marion County Planning Board for four year terms.

# Budget Committee Meeting Notes 1/30/2024

Attendance: Justices Hutchins, White, Nickels (Chair), and Reed (Recorder)

### **Ordinances**

- 1. Redistribution of Sales and Use Tax
- 2. Insurance payment for damaged vehicle \$29,000.00
- 3. Blue and You redistribution \$584.84

### General Discussion

Justice White was concerned about the actual amount of compensation for county employees verses the budgeted amounts. He asked the Comptroller to publish a report with both actual and budgeted compensations.

Justice White requested that known ordinances be sent to the committee members 48 hours prior to the committee meeting. Judge Stumph replied that every effort would be made but retained the need to submit ordinances that were of an immediate need.

Justice White asked who was being considered for the vacant position on the Library Board. The Judge replied that there were two candidates and he would put forth to the Court his choice at the February Court meeting.

Justice Reed expressed a concern that 2024 Numbers and Comp did not include the 10% raises for elected officials. He asked the Comptroller to check. He also requested a new line item in the Quorum Court budget for committee meetings.

The Treasurer noted that the 10% raise for elected officials was not a state mandate. It was however a change in the salary band to the lower value of the band.

Redistribution of Sales and Use Tax (Referred to the Court)

Judge Stumph reached agreement with the Fire Chiefs to reduce the distribution to Rural Fire Departments from 13% to 10%.

The remaining 3% is to be added to Law Enforcement for a total of 27%

The Comptroller noted that that the title refers to the 2024 budget 2023-148. This will be corrected to 2023-149

The Treasurer noted a complication with the effective date of January 1, 2024. She was unsure if the State had distributed Sales and Use Tax for January. She noted that if State distribution had been completed it would be difficult to change the County distributions.



Justice Reed asked the Judge to address the need for proposed budgets from the Fire Departments with the Fire Chiefs for the 2025 budget considerations.

Justice Reed suggested that the committee approve the proposed ordinance and make any changes as necessary at the February Court meeting.

Insurance payment for damaged vehicle - \$29,000.00 (Referred to the Court)

Two errors in the body of the proposed ordinance were noted. 1) The title refers to the 2025 budget as 2023-142. This should be changed to 2023-149, 2) The Treasurer noted that the reference to the account for County General (i.e. 1000.8706) was incorrect. The Comptroller stated that these errors would be corrected.




