# **MARION COUNTY QUORUM COURT MINUTES**

March 9, 2021

The Marion County Quorum Court held its regular meeting, on March 9, 2021 at 6 p.m., at the Marion County Courthouse.

County Judge presided over the meeting. All Justices were present except for Justice Madden.

Pastor Heith Hogan gave the invocation and Justice White led the pledge.

Before business was brought before the court, Judge Massey addressed an article in the newspaper regarding the shutdown of ACIC. He stated that in order to be in compliance with the law, an agreement had to be signed by himself and the Sheriff. When the agreement was signed the shutdown was lifted.

The minutes were approved as were all reports given. During the Fair Board report, Sherry McFarland announced that the dates for the Marion County Fair were August 31 through September 4. Also, there was going to be a rodeo on September 24 and 25. Paul Hudson of the Marion County Planning Board announced that they were looking into precise definitions of subdivisions. Sam Pasting has advised the board to create a whole new ordinance, rather than to try to amend the existing one.

## **Unfinished Business**

## **New Business**

Ordinance 2021-15 – Warning Towers – Sponsored by Justice Madden. This ordinance appropriates \$10,000 from the County Building Improvement Fund to the Emergency Warning Tower fund to cover the cost of repairs in the towers. The motion to adopt was made by Justice Scrima and seconded by Justice Nickels. The motion passed unanimously, with Justice Madden being absent.

A motion to read Ordinance 2021-16 by title only was made by Justice McCalla and seconded by Justice White. The motion was passed unanimously.

Ordinance 2021-16 – 2020 Final Clean Up – Sponsored by the Budget Committee. This ordinance is the final clean up for 2020 after the books were closed on February 28, 2021. The motion to adopt was made by Justice McCalla and seconded by Justice White. The motion passed unanimously.

A motion to read Ordinance 2021-17 by title only was made by Justice Brigham and seconded by Justice McCalla. The motion was passed unanimously.

Ordinance 2021-17 – 2021 Budget & Numbers and Compensation – Sponsored by the Budget Committee. This ordinance cleans up the Budget and Numbers and Compensation ordinance. This is necessary because of the shortfalls after the payment of state taxes and worker's compensation. The motion to adopt was made by Justice McCalla and seconded by Justice Scrima. The motion passed unanimously.

Ordinance 2021-18 – Purchase of Tractor – Sponsored by the Budget Committee. This ordinance allows for Judge Massey to enter into an agreement with Anstaff Bank for the sum of \$139,000.00 to purchase a John Deere Tractor from Greenway Equipment in Conway, Arkansas. This will be a 2020 John Deere 6110M Cab Tractor, Stock #825724. Product identification #1L06110MPKH952613. There will be no money appropriated. The motion to adopt was made by Justice McCalla and seconded by Justice Nickels. The motion passed unanimously.

There was a brief comment from the audience thanking the Judge and all the essential employees for their service during the recent snow storm.

The Marion County Quorum Court held a special meeting on March 18, 2021. The agenda included discussion of the 5.5 hours the jailers and deputies at the Marion County Sheriff's office receive each pay period, the payment of 32 hours to the Marion County Sheriff's office during the snowstorm and consider an ordinance to hire a comptroller.

The prayer was led by Justice Shipman, and the Pledge by Heith Hogan.

County Judge John Massey led the meeting. All justices with the exception of Justice Madden.

Judge Massey announced that the 5.5 hours would be discussed at a later time and that the 32 hours had been resolved and was history.

A motion to read Ordinance 2021-19 regarding the hiring of a comptroller by title only was made by Justice Vancuren and seconded by Justice McCalla. The motion passed unanimously.

Ordinance 2021-19 – To Hire a Comptroller – Sponsored by Justices Scrima, Vancuren, White and Brigham. This ordinance transfers the duties of human resources, payroll and accounts payable from the Clerk's office to the Judge's office. The motion to adopt was made by Justice Vancuren and seconded by Justice Brigham. The motion passed unanimously.

On March 13, 2021, Jacqueline Story, was advised that 911 was having issues around 4:20 P.M. Saturday. She got on the phone with AT&T immediately to see if they were able to see if they could test the trunk lines and see what was going on. They advised that all trunk lines showed to be busied out. She requested they reroute all 911 trunk lines to admin lines through the regular land lines. They then advised her that it was unsuccessful because it appeared that the landlines were being effected as well. She had them reroute them to a cell phone that they have in dispatch and they did successfully. After she got off the phone with them she contacted Yelcot to see if they had heard of any fiber cuts and they advised that they just got word that their link to Windstream was down and would keep her posted. Yelcot notified Jacqueline again later advising that it was a fiber cut but did not know when it would be fixed and that it was a Windstream Fiber. This fiber cut effected long distance calling, cell service in some areas, some SIP calling and 911 (which was able to get rerouted) and Yelcot's internet connection to Windstream. The Media was notified so they could advise the public and it was put on Facebook to advise the public. The fiber was repaired and the link was back up around 3:00 P.M. Sunday.

On 3/14/2021 at around 8:00 P.M. Jacqueline Story received a call from dispatch advising that one of the radio consoles computer tower shut off she came in to see if she could figure out what was wrong with it but it would never turn back on. Scott with Valley Communications was notified and was looking to see if it was covered in the maintenance. The computer was no longer covered since they are older than 5 yrs. old. Don Crespino came and looked at it and believed it was the power supply and replaced the power supply however it still did not work. Don Crespino is working on it to get it fixed. We are also having issues hearing the first responders/fire dept. when we have the channel selected. Scott with Valley Communications has remoted into the system to see if he can see what is going on he was logged in for over 2 hours no luck. He is hoping that when he gets the other console back up and running that it will fix the audio. Dispatch has been using a backup handheld radio so that if they don't get clicked off the channel quick enough they can hear the department talk. However the handheld you also have to switch from central to south and north when the other departments talked if there are more than one talking.

On 3/25/2021, Scott with Valley Communications remoted in and worked on getting the other radio console back up and running. Scott worked on the console again on 3/26 but a cable was loose so he was unable to continue. Scott reconnected on Monday 3/29 and Tuesday 3/30 and was able to get it back up and working.

Scott with Valley Communications was advised by Yellville Fire Chief Billy Evans that Pine Mountain was not receiving their pages and he went in and checked the frequency and there was a number wrong in the frequency so he changed it. Dispatch did a test page to Pine Mountain afterwards but received no answer back so Billy Evans advised when he got back in town he would call dispatch and have them do another test and he would see if it goes through then.

**GRANT REPORT**  
**QUORUM COURT, TUESDAY, April 13, 2021**

**COUNTY**

Cares Act Grant – I presented a list of reimbursables for covid related expenses. **I have prepared an ordinance and it should be included in packet.**

**FIRE DEPARTMENT**

Oakland Promise Land Fire Protection District - Arkansas Rural Community Grant Program - Applicants with an eligible project may apply for up to \$15,000 in state matching funds toward a project for community development or fire protection projects. Oakland Promise Land Fire Protection District has presented plans to purchase 24 tankers for Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBAs). Total cost is 16,980.00. OPLFPD has plans to provide \$8,490.00 and is seeking matching grant funds in the amount of \$8,490.00. This property has been submitted. **They are awaiting word on approval.**

**LIBRARY**

Grant for shelving – **Shelving to arrive approximately in June.** Library has been looking into other grants.

**SHERIFF'S OFFICE**

eCrash/ecite System Grant by the Arkansas State Police – **This grant has been approved and an ordinance has been prepared and should be in packet. This grant is reimburseable from the Arkansas State Police. All receipts must be uploaded into their system before they will reimburse county.** This is a Federal Program. The Sheriff's Office applied to equip 14 vehicles with laptops, printers, scanners, etc. so they could electronically input information regarding accidents or issue citations. They currently have none in their cars. All is done manually. This would help provide the state with more accurate and immediate information for their records and statistics. The total amount was \$52,300.00. There is a 10% local match requirement which would be \$5,230.00. Federal funds requested would be (90%) \$47,000.00. The benefits to our county, region, and state would helpful in accident reporting, insurance claims, and statistical information in determining safety projects.

Mini Step Grant by the Arkansas State Police – There are other grants that the Sheriff's Office would like to work on first. This has been put on the back burner as we have several months until due date. The purpose of the Mini-STEP Subgrant program is to provide funds to law enforcement agencies for highly visible overtime selective traffic enforcement during national/state mobilizations. The applicant must participate in public information and education activities that alert the public to the mobilizations. These could include:

National Distracted Driving mobilization  
National Seat Belt Mobilization  
National Winter DWI Mobilization  
Distracted Driving Mobilization  
National Memorial Day Seat Belt Mobilization  
State July 4<sup>th</sup> Holiday DWI Mobilization  
Sate Speed Mobilization

## National Labor Day DWI Mobilization

This should include but not limited to a minimum of two media exposures (including a pre-news and post news release for each mobilization). The agency will be required to conduct observational seat belt surveys before and after the seat belt mobilization for evaluation purposes.

There are other reimbursements that they could be eligible for as well. **Grant is due August 18, 2021.** The sooner we can submit the grant the better our chances will be to receive it.

Entergy Open Grant – This is a type of grant for community improvement. It is one that can be written for the need.

Blue and You Regular Grants of \$5,000 to \$150,000, with a July 15 application deadline. Sheriff's Office is looking at this grant for bullet proof vests.

Local Law Enforcement Block Grant (LLEBG) – It has a maximum of \$2,550 and deadline for application is February 22, 2021. The Sheriff's Office is looking to purchase flashlights for all officers. **This grant was approved for the total \$2,550.00 to purchase flashlights with safety features and jump boxes to jumpstart vehicles**

Thinking Outside the Box Idea - I know there is a lot involved in upkeep, care, training for dog and partner and I thought of an out of the box idea to look into for your canine unit. The Twin Lakes Playhouse has in the past allowed non-profits to host an evening with funds (or portion thereof) going to the non-profit. Since Covid, I am not sure if they are still doing this or not but would not hurt to ask. Usually, they have one night before their regular performance starts that they will do this. It gives them a dress rehearsal in front of an audience. The non-profit promotes and sells tickets. Again, Covid has required changes be made so not sure if the non-profit would just push people to the Twin Lakes Playhouse website for ticket purchases. People love animals and could probably get a lot of participation. This would be just another way to help fund the canine unit. **UPDATE: Currently the Twin Lakes Playhouse is not having events at this time.**

INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, is made pursuant to Act 430 of ~~1967 and Act~~ 1967 D.C. 742, Chapter 5, Section 90 of the 1977 Acts of Arkansas, by and between the County of Marion, Arkansas, (hereinafter referred to as the county), and the City of Yellville, Arkansas, (hereinafter referred to as the City).

WITNESSETH:

- (I) WHEREAS, the County and the City recognize their respective obligations to provide for the protection of the persons and property of their citizens; and
- (II) WHEREAS, the County and the City have limited financial resources with which to provide for such protection; and
- (III) WHEREAS, the County and the City desire to maximize revenues and the benefits the citizens derive therefrom, and to comply with the mandate of Amendment 10 of the Constitution of the State of Arkansas; and
- (IV) WHEREAS, there is a need to provide increased law enforcement services for the County and City, such as criminal investigation division for processing of felony violations; and
- (V) WHEREAS, the County and City are desirous of an Interlocal Agreement whereby the City would provide revenues to the County, which would in turn, use such revenues for the maintenance of a Metropolitan Branch of the Sheriff's Office of said County, and for elimination of the duplication of finances and personnel between the County and City; and
- (VI) WHEREAS, by entering into such Interlocal Agreement, the City and the County would thereby be able to provide increased and better coordinated law enforcement for their citizens, and effectuate a savings of revenue, thereby allowing the County and the City to comply with Amendment 10 of the Constitution of the State of Arkansas; and
- (VII) WHEREAS, acting completely in good faith, for the purpose of effectuating a savings of County and City revenues, providing greater law enforcement protection for the citizens of the County and the City, and increasing the safety and welfare for all citizens affected hereby;

NOW, THEREFORE, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that for and in consideration of the above premises, and for the mutual obligation hereby created and the mutual benefits so derived, the parties agree as follows:

- (A) The City and the County shall coordinate their efforts to provide for greater law enforcement protection, at a reduced revenue for their citizens through the

Interlocal Agreement. Unless sooner terminated, as provided for herein, this agreement shall be effective January 1st, 2021 and shall run for a period of Twenty Four (24) months thereafter. Provided however, either party may, by majority vote of its respective governing body, elect to modify, or terminate this agreement. In order for this agreement to be modified, the governing bodies of both the City and the County must so indicate by a majority vote of their respective governing bodies. If the parties shall desire to terminate this agreement, the party or parties so desiring to withdraw shall give the other party six (6) months written notification of their intent to withdraw. If either party wishes to terminate this agreement, the agreement will be terminated at the end of the six (6) months notice period. For a period within which this agreement shall exist, the governing bodies may amend said agreement as provided hereinafter in Paragraph O.

- (B) In the event of the termination of this agreement, the parties shall each receive their properties so combined hereby, whether lease, rented, purchased or borrowed. Each party shall keep a list of assets, properly and visibly identified with tags or markings with regard to ownership.
- (C) The City shall upon approval of this agreement, lease to the County and the County shall lease from the City, all municipally owned vehicles, as equipped, which are now being used by the Yellville Police Department, for the sum of one (\$1.00) dollar per year, per vehicle. The City will provide a car every three (3) years, the type of car needed shall be upon the advice and recommendation of the Sheriff, and the City shall receive a six (6) year old car back at the time the new car is delivered. The use of said vehicles and equipment should be primarily for the Metropolitan Branch. The County shall maintain all insurance costs as presently required by the City. In the event of damage to any vehicle which is in excess of any insurance coverage, or in the event that replacement of any vehicle shall become necessary, the City shall provide all revenue necessary for the repair and maintenance or replacement so required. The Metropolitan vehicles will be identified with a distinctive striping and will be used in and near the City of Yellville unless an emergency or unusual circumstances will require their use away from the City. Any significant use of Metropolitan vehicles away from the City shall be reported to the Interlocal Board by the Sheriff. The Metropolitan vehicles shall not be used for any private purpose.
- (D) The County, its officers and employees, shall not be deemed to assume any liability for intentional, negligent act of said City or of officers or employees thereof, and said City shall hold said County and its

as to the number, salary and position of said employees. The County Clerk and the City Clerk shall attend the March regular meeting and any special meetings on a rotating basis.

- (N) The Interlocal Board shall in no way be construed to be Civil Service Commission or Grievance Committee and shall only serve for the effectuation and coordination of this Agreement.
- (O) This Agreement may be amended at any time by the majority vote of both parties. The party desiring to amend this Agreement shall draft their proposed amendment and, after passage by their governing body, submit the proposed amendment to the other party, whereupon said party's governing body shall vote upon said proposed amendment. Should the amendment be accepted by a majority of both parties, it will thereafter become a part and parcel of this Agreement. Should either party fail to approve of a proposed amendment, it will have no force or effect.
- (P) The various provisions and parts of this agreement are hereby declared to be severable and if any section or part of a section, provision herein, is declared unconstitutional, inappropriate or invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not invalidate or effect the remainder of this Agreement.
- (Q) This Agreement supersedes all previous agreement and amendments thereto that relate to the Interlocal Agreement of Law Enforcement.

IN WITNESS HERETO, Marion County, Arkansas, And the City of Yellville, Arkansas, have executed this document by their duly elected officers who are authorized to represent the respective parties hereto in assuring the rights and obligations set forth herein, retroactive to January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021 on this 4th day of January, 2021.

the enforcement of the provisions and agreements contained herein.

- (J) The revenue as presently derived from Municipal Court fines shall continue to be divided between the City and the County according to the location of the offense, and the City Attorney and the County Prosecutor shall continue to cause the offenses to be prosecuted in the same manner, as was the case before this agreement. For example, should a misdemeanor citation be issued inside the corporate limits of the City, the City would retain all fines collected as a result thereof. The County in a like manner would retain all Municipal Court fines which resulted from arrests or citations within the County, but outside the City limits.
- (K) The Sheriff is authorized to use any employee as the Sheriff deems necessary which are a part of the Metropolitan Branch for the purpose of investigating alleged felony offenses of the Arkansas Criminal Code which may occur in either the County or the City. The Sheriff is authorized to use the other Metropolitan officers in any manner he deems appropriate for providing law enforcement protection for the citizens of the County and the City, recognizing, however, that the primary use of said Metropolitan Branch shall be for the protection of the residents of the City and that the primary purpose of the Yellville Summit School Resource Officer shall be the protection, guidance and nurture of the students of Yellville Summit Public School.
- (L) There shall be a Board created by the City and the County for the purpose of effectuating this Agreement and coordinating the efforts necessary for carrying out this agreement. This Board shall consist of the Sheriff of the County, the Mayor of the City, the County Judge, one (1) member of the City Council of the City of Yellville appointed by the Mayor and approved by the City Council, and one (1) member of the Quorum Court of Marion County, appointed by the County Judge and approved by the Quorum Court. The sole purpose of this Board shall be to carry out the purposes of the Agreement and to coordinate the effort of the parties that may arise from time to time.
- (M) The Interlocal Board shall meet twice a year on the third Tuesday of March and on the third Tuesday of September, the September meeting being the annual meeting. Special meetings may be called as the need arises by the Mayor, the Sheriff, the County Judge or any member of the Interlocal Board. The County Clerk and the City Clerk shall attend the annual meeting for the purpose of keeping minutes. They shall provide copies of the minutes to the City Council, and Quorum Court. At the annual meeting, the County Clerk shall give a report regarding the Sheriff's Office personnel



officers and employees harmless from and shall defend said County and its officers, employees and agents against any claim for damages resulting therefrom.

- (E) The City, its officers, employees, and agents, shall not be deemed to assume any liability for intentional, negligent or reckless acts of said County or of officers, employees, or agents thereof, and said County shall defend said City and its officers, employees and agents against any claim for damages resulting therefrom.
- (F) The composition of the Metro Branch as to the number of personnel and their positions will be approved on an annual basis by the Yellville City Council upon the advice and recommendation of the County Sheriff. The Sheriff shall make such recommendations to the City Council on or before the first scheduled Council meeting in October.
- (G) The City shall provide sufficient revenues to the County, on a monthly basis, whereby the salaries, health insurance, pension fund, workers compensation, and other reasonably necessary personnel cost are funded for the personnel which shall be in accordance with the overall pay scale of the Sheriff's Department in such a way that there would be no salary advantage or disadvantage for personnel of the Metropolitan Branch. Metropolitan personnel will not be transferred to the County without being replaced. If a deputy resigns, is terminated or for any other reason leaves the Sheriff's Department, any training that is required to replace that deputy will be paid by the City if the slot to be filled is in the Metropolitan Branch, and will be paid by the County if it is a County Deputy slot to be filled.
- (H) The County shall be responsible for all fuel, charges associated with the County vehicles. The City shall be responsible for a monthly sum up to \$1000.00 of fuel allowance for all Metropolitan vehicles. Should all of the Metropolitan vehicles have fuel charges in excess of said \$1000.00, the County shall bear the costs of such excess.
- (I) The personnel which constitute the Metropolitan Branch shall be under the direction, supervision, authority and control of the Sheriff of Marion County, Arkansas. The City shall, upon acceptance of this agreement, provide the funds and ordinances necessary to accomplish this agreement. In a like manner, the County, upon acceptance of this agreement, shall take all steps necessary for providing the funds and ordinances necessary for the enactment and enforcement of this agreement. Each party agrees to act in the utmost good faith and to take all steps necessary of



Now comes a need for police protection in the City of Summit, Arkansas and whereas the City of Yellville Arkansas has an inter-local agreement with the Marion County Sheriff's department for police protection known as the METRO agreement and wishes to assist the City of Summit with the police protection it desperately needs and desires.

Therefore: The City of Summit wishes to enter into an annual agreement with the City of Yellville for the purpose of giving the Sheriff of Marion County the authority to dispatch deputies working for the Yellville Metro Division to the City of Summit when needed and for normal patrol duty along with the protection and enforcement of all laws of the citizens of the City of Summit.

**SECTION 1**

The City of Summit agrees to pay and the City of Yellville agrees to accept payment in the amount of \$12,000.00 annually starting on JANUARY 1, 2021 and ending on DECEMBER 30, 2022. The City of Yellville will submit to the City of Summit a bill in the amount of \$12,000.00 along with the executed agreement and the City of Summit agrees to make 12 consecutive payments to the City of Yellville in the amount of \$1,000.00 each on the first day of each month. Any amount that goes 20 days past due may be subject to a 15% late penalty. For the purpose of this agreement no prorated amounts will be figured for the beginning or ending of this agreement nor for any time period during the agreement. Any delinquent payments over 30 days will be cause for immediate termination of service and nullify this agreement without notice to the City of Summit. The City of Summit will also be responsible for any and all legal fees assessed to the City of Yellville for the collection or associated with any process, services or litigation to collect any such payments, late penalties or fees. The City of Yellville shall deposit all funds paid by the City of Summit into the Metro Vehicle fund held by the City of Yellville.

**SECTION 2**

The Sheriff of Marion County agrees that the terms of this agreement are cost neutral to his department and requires no new charges or payments of funds in addition to the Yellville Metro agreement that is already in place between Marion County and the City of Yellville. The Sheriff agrees to use the Metro officers as needed and allow the officers to assist the City of Summit with city ordinance issues as they arise. With this agreement the City of Yellville gives authority to the Sheriff to direct, dispatch and knowingly use members of the Yellville Metro division in a

manner he sees fit to patrol and enforce the law in the City of Summit, AR. The Sheriff agrees to use the table below as a guide to schedule patrols but understands the table is a guide only. The sheriff may use his/her best judgments on time management however acknowledges that the priority of the Yellville Metro officers is for the citizens of the City of Yellville.

### **SECTION 3**

The City of Summit understands there is a lack of resources in the city for police protection, collection of fines and municipal court duty and a need exists for this agreement. The City of Summit acknowledges that the City of Yellville will be providing this service at a rate substantially lower than it would cost to maintain their own departments. Therefore the City of Summit will allow all revenue gained from any and all citations issued in the City of Summit to go to the City of Yellville general funds. The City of Summit with this agreement waves its right to any funds collected for citations issued by law enforcement while working within the corporate limits of the city.

### **SECTION 4**

The City of Yellville will handle all citations as if they were issued within the city limits of Yellville and will not provide any type of routine special reporting of revenue, court cases or citation's issued to the city of Summit. The Yellville Municipal court clerk will manage all citations issued and handle them in the normal course of business with the municipal court as if they were citations issued in the City of Yellville. Any special reports will have to be requested by the City of Summit in written form and may be subject to additional fees for processing.

### **SECTION 5**

The City of Yellville will not supply any additional officers, vehicles, equipment, labor hours or overtime wages to comply with any of the terms of this agreement. The sole purpose of this agreement is to allow the Yellville metro officers to enter into the corporate limits of the City of Summit and provide basic patrol and law enforcement duties in the course of their normally scheduled work hours while working in, near and for the City of Yellville at the discretion of the Marion County Sheriff under the aforementioned Metro agreement.

### **SECTION 6**

By signing this agreement the City of Summits, Mayor, Governing body, boards, committees, employees and citizens understand that the City of Yellville Metro Division along with the Marion County Sheriff's Department has all the rights and powers given by the State of Arkansas law and will enforce all said laws of its jurisdiction not excluding Federal, State, County and City law. It should be noted that only city ordinances of the City of Summit that have properly been passed and advertised to the public by proper procedure will be enforced within the city limits of Summit. No ordinances of any other municipal jurisdiction will be enforced inside the corporate limits of the City of Summit. All such ordinances shall be made

available to all officers and a hard copy kept on file at the Summit city hall for the public to review.

#### **SECTION 7**

The Mayor of the City of Summit gives authority to the Sheriff of Marion County to utilize the resources available to him/her to protect the citizens of the City of Summit. No guarantees of patrol hours, times, dates or schedules are included in the terms of this agreement. Services will be provided on an as needed and when time permits basis. It shall be understood that all Yellville metro resources shall be committed to the City of Yellville at any and all times regardless of situations that may arise in the City of Summit. In the event of a natural or man-made disaster Yellville Metro officers, vehicles, equipment and resources will be committed to the City of Yellville. Resources and manpower will be made available to the City of Summit when available without causing any disruption of services to the citizens of the City of Yellville.

#### **SECTION 8**

The City of Summit holds harmless the City of Yellville, Marion County, the Marion County Sheriff's Office and all respective elected officials, governing bodies, boards, committees and employees from any damages, lawsuits or proceedings that might arise under any article of this agreement. The City of Summit also holds harmless the aforementioned from any litigation, proceeding or lawsuit from any Summit city code or ordinance violation case that might arise. In the event of any type of litigation case, the jurisdiction for any trial will be that of Marion County, Arkansas. The City of Yellville or Marion County will not be responsible for any legal fee's that might arise from any litigation or claims brought against the City of Summit.

#### **SECTION 9**

In no way shall this agreement be mistaken for any acknowledgement of liability by the City of Yellville or the Marion County Sheriff's department for any and all matters concerning the City of Summit. In the event of any litigation the City of Summit will provide it's own legal representation and resources and shall not rely on any representation or resources provided to the City of Yellville or to Marion County. Any legal matters or expenses that might arise between any of the parties resulting in court proceeding's as the result of any citation issued on a city code violation will be the responsibility of the City of Summit.

#### **SECTION 10**

Any patrol matters or request for extra patrol shall be submitted by the Mayor of the City of Summit directly to the Marion County Sheriff for consideration. It will be left up to the discretion of the Sheriff to assign, dispatch or schedule these requests with his staff not to exclude the Yellville Metro division. In the event the Sheriff feels the requests and services are taking more than the allotted amount of valued time as indicated in the table below for services, he may report the said overage of times and calls to the Mayor of the City of Yellville so to terms of this agreement maybe reevaluated for any new agreements.

#### **SECTION 11**

An allotted value for time has been calculated in the table below as to give some type of value for the services being provided. This is a guide as to the amount of time and resources that are being made available to the City of Summit for the funds received. It shall be understood that these figures shall be used for any type of calculation of time and resources in the event of any type of litigation or disagreement in the future as to how much time should be spent performing any duties assigned to the City of Summit for compensation. These are also the figures that shall be used in the event of any time calculations subject to any type of disaster funds that may be applied for in the event of a natural disaster.

**TABLE:**

- City of Yellville payment to Marion County for Metro \$93,600.00 annually
- Hours of work annually = 40 hour week x 52 weeks x 2 officers = 4160 hours
- Vehicle cost depreciated over 36 months at \$10,000 annually
- City of Summit's agreed upon contribution of \$12,000 annually
- \$24.90 Loaded man hour (salary, equipment, maintenance and benefits)
- 481.92 annual hours expected to be spent in Summit on patrol
- 20 = number of days per month that Metro officers work on average




