WHEREAS, on December 3, 2008, the Marion County Quorum Court Enacted Ordinance No. 2008-40 to repeal Ordinance 2008-39 terminated the existing Marion County Library Board and reorganized the Marion County Library Board in accordance with A.C.A. 13-2-401 and A.C.A. 14-14-705.

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2008-40 returned the Marion County Library Board from an Advisory Board to an Administrative Library Board.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF MARION COUNTY, ARKANSAS, THAT:

Section 1. That the existing Marion County Library Board shall continue to administer and operate the Marion County Library.

Section 2. That all individuals employed now and in the future by the Marion County Library shall be county employees for the purpose of benefits and compensation.

Section 3. That all Library Employees shall be subject to and be under the Marion County Employee Policy.

Section 4. Further any and all employee compensation shall be subject to the direction of the rules and regulations for Marion County Employees as set forth by Quorum Court and Administered by the County Judge.

Section 5. That any contracts and or leases that would be binding upon the Board and or the Library shall require review and approval of the Marion County Judge and filed of record with the Clerk of the Court.

Section 6. Whereas this Ordinance is considered an emergency and is effective immediately.

Section 7. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE: The various Articles and parts of this Ordinance are to be considered severable and therefore, if any Article or part is found to be invalid for any reason, it shall not invalidate the remaining Provisions hereof.
