

Ordinance 2023-148

BE ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF MARION COUNTY, ARKANSAS. AN ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED:

AN APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERCENTAGE BREAKDOWN OF MARION COUNTY'S ONE-PERCENT COUNTY-WIDE SALES AND USE TAX.

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary to reassign the percentage of Sales Tax monies in the following manner beginning with monies received in January 1, 2024.

**ARTICLE 1.** Distribution of Sales Tax funds listed in Ordinance 2023-55 are hereby amended to read as follows:

45.00%	County Road
24.00%	Law Enforcement
18.00%	Transfer Station
<u>13.00%</u>	Rural fire Departments
100.00%




