

Ordinance 2022-82

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION STRUCTURE FOR THE DEPUTIES OF THE MARION SHERIFF'S OFFICE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2018-4 IDENTIFIED AS THE MARION COUNTY PERSONNEL POLICY TO INCLUDE COMPENSATION FOR CERTIFIED LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS WHO HAVE ATTAINED LAW ENFORCEMENT CERTIFICATION AS DEFINED BY THE ARKANSAS COMMISSION ON LAW ENFORCEMENT STANDARDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF MARION COUNTY, ARKANSAS:

Article 1. The Marion County Personnel Policy is amended as follows:

Under the Employee Benefits and Compensation portion of the Personnel Policy, the following will be added:

"Certified Law Enforcement Officer Additional Salary Payments."

All full-time Certified Law Enforcement Officers employed by the Marion County Sheriff's Department shall receive additional per annum compensation of \$300.00 per certificate who have obtained law enforcement certification as defined by the Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standard and Training for the attainment of the "Basic Certificate", "General Certificate", "Intermediate Certificate", "Advanced Certificate", and the "Senior Certificate". The additional compensation shall be payable starting on the January 1st each year following receipt of said certificate(s). A copy of the certificate(s) must be filed with the County Clerk to receive the additional compensation.

Article 2. The award of an additional salary payment under this section is contingent upon the existence of sufficient funding independent of funding specifically set aside for other programs within the Marion County Sheriff's Department. These certificate pay payments shall be payable out of Fund 3018 – County Detention Facility Fund subject to fund availability pursuant to §12-41-505 Arkansas Code Annotated.

Article 3. Severability Clause: If any provision or article of this Ordinance is held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions and articles of this Ordinance, and to such end the provisions and articles of the Ordinance are declared severable.

Article 4. All county employees and elected officials involved herein are directed to prepare any documentation necessary and to perform all duties necessary to effectuate this ordinance.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF MARION COUNTY, ARKANSAS, AN
ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED:

AMENDMENT TO THE ANNUAL OPERATING BUDGET AND NUMBERS AND
COMPENSATION ORDINANCE 2021-124 AND ORDINANCE 2022-13, TO ESTABLISH
GUIDELINES FOR EXPENDITURE OF AMERICAN RESUE PLAN ACT FUNDS.

SECTION 1. The Quorum Court desires to establish guidelines for the appropriation of monies
from the American Rescue Plan Act Fund ("ARPA") received from the U.S. Treasury in 2022.

SECTION 2. The Quorum Court desires to prioritize the expenditure of ARPA funds by
allocating as much of those funds as needed for the sole purpose of supporting all County
related expenditures and requests, as allowed by the federal guidelines.

SECTION 3. The Quorum Court desires that the remaining ARPA funds, subject to the existing
County, State, and Federal eligibility requirements, to be available to support funding requests
by all other non-governmental organizations.

SECTION 4. All non-governmental organizations that receive funds under this Ordinance shall
be deemed eligible, in accord with federal guidance, by the Quorum Court with assistance, if
necessary, by a third party. Quorum Court shall create a process for applicants in collaboration
with the County Judge's Office. If necessary, a third party shall be selected by the County
Judge to assist with the process.

SECTION 5. All county employees and elected officials involved herein shall prepare all
documentation necessary to effectuate the sections described above.




