### MARION COUNTY QUORUM COURT MINUTES

August 15, 2023

The Marion County Quorum Court held their monthly meeting beginning at 6 p.m. on August 15, 2023.

Judge Stumph presided over the meeting and all Justices were present with the exception of Justice Scrima. Jim Hampton gave the invocation and Judge Stumph led the Pledge.

Due to the number of elected officials who attended the AAC meeting on August 8, 2023, the meeting was changed to August 15.

The July minutes were approved.

The Treasurer's report and the Sheriff's report were verbally given. During the Treasurer's report, Ms. Crespino announced that during the AAC meeting she had learned that there was a way to get a sales tax rebate for the county from the state. This rebate can go back one year and she is going to be working on gathering the claims to submit for this rebate. This will be additional revenue for the county. All other reports had been submitted to the Justices for their viewing and there were no questions regarding any of the other reports. Also, the minutes from the Personnel and Budget committees were presented.

The motion read the ordinances by title only was made by Justice Vanculen and seconded by Justice McCalla. The motion passed unanimously.

Ordinance 2023-86 – Judge's Office – Amending 2023 Budget – Sponsored by Justices Nickels, White, Reed, Hutching and McCalla. This ordinance transfers monies from unappropriated funds for expenses that were paid in 2023 for actual expenses incurred in 2022. The motion to adopt was made by Justice Vancuren and seconded by Justice McCalla. During discussion a motion to amend the ordinance to remove from Section 1, the verbiage that stated "since no clean-up Ordinance was done." The motion was made by Justice Vancuren and seconded by Justice Brigham. The motion to amend passed unanimously. The vote to adopt also passed unanimously.



Ordinance 2023-87 – Judge's Office – Second Quarter Fuel Transfer – Sponsored by Justices Nickels, White, Reed, Hutching and McCalla. This ordinance transfers the funds for gas purchased from various county departments via Road Shop fuel tanks for the second quarter of the year in the amount of \$1210.84. The motion to adopt was made by Justice Reed and seconded by Justice Nickels. During discussion Justice Vancuren questioned the reasoning behind putting the E-911 fund in the ordinance with the amount of zero dollars. He made a motion to amend the ordinance to remove all the E-911 references. The motion was seconded by Justice Brigham. The motion passed unanimously. The motion to adopt also passed unanimously.

Ordinance 2023-88 – Clerk's Office – Amending the Procedure's Ordinance – Sponsored by Justice Reed, Nickels, and Hutching. This ordinance amends Section 3 of Ordinance 2023-1. The amendment changes the time of any reports, ordinances or other documents needed to be presented to the Justices to be turned into the Clerk's office no later that noon, seven days prior to the meeting date. This changes the time from 3:30 p.m. to noon. The motion to adopt was made by Justice Reed and seconded by Justice Hutching. The motion passed unanimously.

Ordinance 2023-89 – Clerk's Office – Postage Reimbursement – Sponsored by the Budget Committee. This ordinance reimburses the Clerk's office for the postage used by the other offices in the courthouse, from February 1, 2023 through June 30, 2023. The motion to adopt was made by Justice McCalla and seconded by Justice Reed. The motion passed unanimously.

Ordinance 2023-90 – Clerk's Office – Wage Increase – Sponsored by Justices Hutching, McCalla and Nickels. The ordinance allows for an increase in wages for the deputies in the Clerk's office from \$15.60 to \$17.60 per hour from County General for one deputy and from \$13.25 to \$15.25 per hour from the Recorder's fund for two deputies. The motion to adopt was made by Justice Hutching and seconded by Justice Shipman. Clerk Moffet, asked to be recognized, and announced that she wanted to amend the ordinance to strike out sections four and five, which would have made the ordinance retroactive to January 1, 2023. The motion to amend was made by Justice Reed and seconded by Justice White and passed unanimously. Justice White mentioned that he was still against this ordinance as he thought it should be two separate ordinances as it was two separate offices. He continued by stating that two of the deputies worked in the Recorder's office and one worked in the Clerk's office, and that the two working in the Recorder's office were being punished due to the Clerk asking for too high of a wage for the deputy that works in the Clerk's office. Clerk Moffet responded that she had lowered the amount of the wage increase by \$1 per hour. He continued by stating that \$13.00 per hour is a living wage, as with the benefits the county gives the pay is actually over \$38,000 per year. The motion to adopt was defeated with Justices Nickels, Reed, Hutching, Shipman and McCalla in favor of the motion and Justices Vancuren, White and Brigham against the ordinance.

Ordinance 2023-91 – Clerk's Office – Jury Reimbursement & Jurors and Witnesses – Sponsored by Justices McCalla, White, Nickels, Reed and Hutching. This ordinance appropriates a jury reimbursement in the amount of \$934.21 from the County General fund into the line item for the Jury Per Diem. Also, it creates a line item for Jurors and Witnesses (1000-0405-9092) for the purpose of paying witnesses for their expenses. The amount of \$25,000 is to be appropriated from the County General fund. The motion to adopt was made by Justice Reed and seconded by Justice McCalla. The motion passed unanimously.

Ordinance 2023-92 – Assessor's Office – Wage Increase – Sponsored by the Budget Committee. This ordinance would allow the Assessor to give \$3.00 per hour raises to her deputies. The motion to adopt was made by Justice Hutching and seconded by Justice Shipman. There was no discussion. The motion failed with Justices Nickels, Vancuren, White, Reed, Brigham and McCalla voting against it, and Justices Hutching and Shipman voting in favor of it.

Ordinance 2023-93 – Assessor's Office – Transfer of Funds – Sponsored by the Budget Committee. This ordinance allows for the transfer of \$5,000.00 from the Machinery/Equipment line item into the Small Equipment for the purchase of four new printers. The motion to adopt was made by Justice Reed and seconded by Justice McCalla. Justice Brigham asked why the money needed to be transferred. Assessor Eppes responded that it was coming from the Capital Outlay category into the Supplies category as the amount of the Capital Outlay amount was raised to \$2,500 per item at last month's meeting. The motion to adopt passed unanimously.

Ordinance 2023-94 – Assessor's Office – PDR Payments – Sponsored by the Budget Committee. This ordinance affirms that the court acknowledges that it is the responsibility of the county to disburse, through the county payroll system, the Professional development Recognition Payments (PDR) funded by the State of Arkansas to qualifying personnel who actively work with the property taxes. The motion to adopt was made by Justice Reed and seconded by Justice McCalla and was passed unanimously.

Ordinance 2023-95 – Sheriff's Office – Corp of Engineers – Sponsored by the Budget Committee. This ordinance appropriates the money from the Corps of

Engineers that is received monthly to pay the wages to Marion County deputies for park patrol during the moths of May 2023 through September 2023. The motion to adopt was made by Justice Reed and seconded by Justice McCalla. During the discussion Justice White asked if Section 1 was necessary. Section 1 read as follows: "No revenue was appropriated or accounted for in the 2023 Marion County Budget by the Marion County Quorum Court for Fund 3046 – Corps of Engineers." Justice White did not believe that it was the Quorum Courts error. Sheriff Alexander stated that his office came in with an incorrect budget and that he wasn't sure who was to blame. Justice Brigham made the motion to amend the ordinance to strike section 1. Justice Vancuren seconded it and the motion passed unanimously. More discussion entailed to explain that the Corps pays \$43 per hour to the County. The deputies get \$23.50 per hour and the rest goes to fuel and maintenance of the vehicles. The motion to adopt passed unanimously.

Ordinance 2023-96 – Sheriff's Office – Wage Increase – Sponsored by Justice Brigham, Vancuren, McCalla, Scrima and White. This ordinance amends the numbers and compensation portion of Ordinance 22-98 for the Marion County Sheriff's Department and Detention Center. Salary rates only affect Deputies (8), CID Investigator (1) and Marion County Detention Center Jail Administrator, Jailers (15) and Transport Officer for the remaining ten (10) pay periods of 2023. The motion to adopt was made by Justice Vancuren and seconded by Justice Hutching. During discussion Justice Reed asked if numbers and compensation can be changed during the year. Justice Vancuren commented that the number and compensation will show the maximum amount and is not necessarily what the employees are being paid. An example was given that when deputies leave the new hires may not receive that same pay. The motion passed unanimously.

Justice Vancuren asked about contracts with the rural Fire Departments. He stated that all contracts were to be reviewed by the Quorum Court before being signed by the County Judge. County Attorney John Russo stated that the contracts need to be approved by the Quorum Court, however, if the money has already been appropriated the County Judge can sign the contracts.

Marie Thompson with the Marion County Community Services, introduced Shane Deming to summarize the efforts and progress of the Community Center. The Court was thanked for allocating ARPA funds to reduce the expenses for creating a better access to the property. The property is being cleared and leveled. A floorplan is being created and will be presented at a later date.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:15 p.m.

**SECTION 1.** This Court affirms the construction of a multi-function protective concrete surface area for the Promise Land Area Community Organization (PLACO) would be useful to the residents of Marion County. PLACO is a community center that survives on wonderful volunteers and small fundraisers. This area will be used for the organization's outdoor activities including fund raising events, outdoor recreation, and community networking/outreach programs. This is a recommended use of ARPA funding in accordance with the Final rule issued by the U.S. Treasury. Therefore, this Court declares that the funds would help in the construction of a multi-function protective concrete surface area for the Promise Land Area Community Organization (PLACO) to be budgeted as set forth in this ordinance.

**SECTION 2.** The Promise Land Area Community Organization (PLACO) 501(c)(3) is a non-profit organization with the mission to provide a community center for community gatherings, exercise or recreational activities and fundraising.
