Be it enacted by the Quorum Court of Marion County, Arkansas; an Ordinance to be entitled:

An ordinance amending the annual operating budget and numbers and compensation Ordinance 2021-124 for the calendar year 2022 for Marion County, Arkansas, for the purpose of funding the election budget until the end of the year.

The state reimbursement has not yet been sent to Marion County and according to the State Board of Elections it may not get here before the end of the year.

Article 1: The school districts have sent their reimbursements for their portion of the primary election in the amount of \$7488.99, and that amount has been placed in the County General fund. These monies and an additional \$15823.26 from County General (1000 – County General) need to be appropriated into the following line items:

BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF MARION COUNTY, ARKANSAS, AN ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ANNUAL OPERATING BUDGET AND NUMBERS AND COMPENSATION ORDINANCE 2021-124 AND ORDINANCE 2022-13 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2022 FOR MARION COUNTY, ARKANSAS. APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE PURCHASE OF A CORONER VEHICLE AND BODY STORAGE CONTAINER AND RELATED EXPENSES OF EACH IS NECESSARY FOR THE POSITION OF COUNTY CORONER.

SECTION 1. This appropriation is for the transfer of funds for the cost of purchasing a coroner vehicle and body storage container necessary for the position of County Coroner.
