Please observe silence in the church after Mass out of respect for Our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament and so as not to disturb people who are praying.

**Fr. Bernard Hall is closed until further notice.**

Please stay out of the cordoned off area, the vestibule, baptismal chapel, bathroom and choir loft as well as the area under the choir loft, this is for your safety. The engineering firm has requested we stay out of this area for now. **FBH Restroom Access is no longer restricted since they are the only restrooms currently accessible.**

FOR OUR VISITORS: In 2010 the Vatican clarified that there is no provision for receiving Holy Communion in the hand at the Traditional Latin Mass. The universal norm for the reception of Holy Communion throughout the world is to receive on the tongue at all Masses in either form. However in the United States, those who wish to receive in the hand may do so but only at the new form of Mass, not at the Traditional Latin Mass. The Bishops of the United States have further clarified that this decision is left to the individual receiving not the minister.

The Church of the Assumption has preserved the traditional practices regarding the reception of Holy Communion. Many of our parishioners feel very strongly that Communion in the hand is not appropriately reverent for such a solemn moment. As our Guests, please respect the customary practices of the Church of the Assumption and in charity consider the sincere and deeply held beliefs of our parishioners as you approach Holy Communion.

If you would like to donate towards the flowers on the altars please contact the church office. Flowers on the altars have been arranged for a balanced appearance. Do not place unapproved flowers on the altar, these will be removed and disposed of.

**May Crowning** All are invited to meet in the Courtyard at 9:30am on Sunday, May 3rd, for our May crowning celebration. All children are invited to process from the courtyard area to the Marian statue by the church, and lay flowers at the feet of Mary. Flowers will be provided for the children to give to Our Lady.

**Policy on Supervision of Children on Assumption**

**Property** In accordance with the Diocesan Safe Environment Policies and best practices, as of January 1, 2023, all children 12 years and younger must be accompanied by a parent, adult or sibling over 16 years old while on all Assumption property.

**Construction Update:** Please be aware that work will be ongoing on the property and that we are once again a construction site. Stay aware of your safety and that of your family. The engineering firm is working with us to help repair the church roof which is sagging about 5 inches and repair the masonry arches in the steeple which have cracks in them. The vestibule area of the church is closed until the tower has been reinforced and eventually repaired. This work has been delayed waiting for the steel that has been ordered to arrive. In addition the construction company has yet to hire a masonry company to complete the work through no fault of their own. Bliemel Park is closed until further notice. Please be patient with us as we are still struggling to take care of some remaining details to complete the church.
