FOR OUR VISITORS: In 2010 the Vatican clarified that there is no provision for receiving Holy Communion in the hand at the Traditional Latin Mass. The universal norm for the reception of Holy Communion throughout the world is to receive on the tongue at all Masses in either form. However in the United States, those who wish to receive in the hand may do so but only at the new form of Mass, not at the Traditional Latin Mass. The Bishops of the United States have further clarified that this decision is left to the individual receiving not the minister.

The Church of the Assumption has preserved the traditional practices regarding the reception of Holy Communion. Many of our parishioners feel very strongly that Communion in the hand is not appropriately reverent for such a solemn moment. As our Guests, please respect the customary practices of the Church of the Assumption and in charity consider the sincere and deeply held beliefs of our parishioners as you approach Holy Communion.

If you would like to donate towards the flowers on the altars please contact the church office. Flowers on the altars have been arranged for a balanced appearance. Do not place unapproved flowers on the altar, these will be removed and disposed of.

Fr. Price requests that at weekday Masses for reasons of security, please enter the church via the courtyard and the south transept door. Thank you.
