Financial and Attendance Commitment

Tuition for Class XVII will be \$1,075 and includes the retreat, all modules, meals, materials, and graduation.

Tuition is due in full by September 14, 2023, and is non-refundable.

Students are expected to attend all of the full-day modules. Participation in the overnight retreat is required.
