



South Street Improvements

The Village of Botkins will begin Phase 1 of the South Street Reconstruction Project this spring as part of its ongoing commitment to maintaining and improving community infrastructure. While the construction will take place specifically along South Street—from Robinhood Drive through the First Street intersection—the project represents a broader investment that benefits the entire Village by strengthening essential utilities and improving long-term reliability.

Construction is scheduled to begin in March, weather permitting, and is expected to continue through the spring and summer months, with completion anticipated toward the end of summer. The project includes a full roadway reconstruction down to the base, followed by stabilization to ensure long-term durability. In addition, crews will install a new, larger waterline, replace the stormwater system with updated connections, and construct new curbs and sidewalks to improve drainage, safety, and walkability.

This work is the first phase of planned improvements for South Street, with Phase 2 tentatively scheduled for 2027. While construction can be inconvenient, these upgrades are designed to provide lasting value, reduce future maintenance needs, and enhance the overall appearance and function of the area. The Village appreciates the patience and cooperation of residents during construction and will continue to share updates as the project progresses.
