Ordinance No. 26-05**

**A RESOLUTION APPOINTING BOTKINS MAYOR LANCE
SYMONDS AS THE MUNICIPAL REPRESENTATIVE TO THE
SHELBY COUNTY 9-1-1 PROGRAM REVIEW COMMITTEE**

WHEREAS, as provided in ORC 128.06 every county shall maintain a county 9-1-1 Program Review Committee, which shall serve without compensation and shall consist of six voting members.

WHEREAS, a member of the legislative authority of a municipal corporation in the county selected by the majority of the legislative authorities of municipal corporations in the county pursuant to resolutions they adopts shall be appointed to the 911 Program Review Committee.

WHEREAS, Botkins Mayor Lance Symonds has agreed to serve as the municipal representative to the Shelby County 9-1-1 Program Review Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of Botkins, Ohio, a majority of the members elected thereto concurring herein:

SECTION 1:

That Lance Symonds is hereby appointed to the Shelby County 9-1-1 Program Review Committee as the municipal representative.


SECTION 2:
