EXPLANATION OF SERVICES

Professional & Staff Services:

Co-ordinating Activities, Rites, Ceremonies-including but not limited to;

- Professional consultation with licensed personnel, including but not limited to, expert advice on options to meet your specific needs
- Co-ordination with the hospital or other place of death
- Co-ordination of Clergy
- Co-ordination of Musicians
- Co-ordination of Cemetery and/or Crematorium
- Co-ordination of Coroner and other necessary contacts
- Preparing and placing death notices (where included)
- Procuring necessary documents & permits
- Filing registration with the province
- Overseeing all other staff functions necessary to implement the arrangements
- Handling of bio-hazardous waste

Documentation, Permits, Forms, etc.

- Completion and filing of all documents necessary to carry out the services and supplies requested, including, but not limited to, death registration, burial permit, coroner's certificate for cremation, documentation required to ship the deceased out of country
- Provision of 12 Proof of Death Certificates issued by Rushnell Family Services our Proof of Death Certificates are usually accepted for most estate settlement purposes, however at times a provincial "Death Certificate" will be necessary and is available from the office of the Registrar General. Note that the Registrar's office guarantees processing time only as fifteen (15) days with delivery time extra and are sent by regular mail.

Transport Remains (From Place of Death)

(within 20 kms; additional fees apply beyond 20 kms of \$2.35 per km) One Way

- Transportation of the remains from one place to another; for example, from the place of death (hospital, long term care facility, residence, etc.) to the funeral home. A charge applies for each transportation need and request.

Minimal Preparation

- The minimal preparation of the deceased body for placement into the casket, including bathing, disinfection, dressing, setting of facial features for identification or viewing without embalming.

Embalming of Remains

- Embalming is the process of replacing blood and bodily fluids with chemical preservative liquids. It is a process of sanitation, restoration and temporary preservation. Embalming is not legally required, but may be recommended to preserve the body between time of death and the visitation or disposition of the deceased. Our professional funeral directors will make a recommendation based on the condition of the deceased body and expected service requirements.

Unless otherwise identified, all prices do not include applicable taxes.

Facilities for Preparations/Embalming/Shelter

- Facilities used to prepare, embalm, and shelter the deceased body. This facility is constructed with requirements from the Bereavement Authority of Ontario laws and is annually inspected by the Ministry of Health.

Staff Services for Visitation/ General Service Areas

- Bookkeeping
- Processing of memorial donations
- Government regulatory fees
- Annual audit as required by the Provincial Government

The preparation for visiting hours including:

- Arrangement of casket or urn and flowers in our visitation room
- Funeral director & assistants to supervise the visiting hours
- Receptionist to accept and place memorial donations
- Funeral director & assistants to conduct fraternal or lodge services

Facilities for Visitation

The use of our premises, furnishings, and equipment for the reception of friends and relatives for visitation.

Equipment may include any or all of the following:

- Register desk
- Lectern
- Audio/Visual equipment
- Religious equipment
- Flower & donation cards (display stand)
- Casket bier, urn arc, or urn display table

Staff Services for Ceremony

- Arrangement of casket or urn and flowers in our chapel, church or other location
- Funeral director & assistants to conduct the funeral or memorial service
- Receptionist to accept and place memorial donations; Care and delivery of flowers to cemetery, nursing homes, and/or other locations

Facilities for Ceremony (Chapel)

- The use of our premises, furnishings, and equipment for the funeral or memorial services

Note: A memorial service is a service where neither the deceased nor a casket is present. At most memorial services the urn containing the cremated remains are present.

Note about vehicles

~ all vehicles required to provide the requested services will only be driven by funeral home staff ~

Funeral Coach/Hearse

The use of this specialized vehicle includes the transportation of the deceased from the Funeral Home to the Cemetery or Crematorium, or from the Funeral Home to the Church or other location of the Funeral and to the Cemetery or Crematorium.

Clergy/Lead Car

The use of the car may include any or all of the following:

- Transportation of Clergy to Funeral Home or other location for Funeral or Memorial Service
- Transportation of Clergy to Cemetery or Crematorium
- Leading of the Funeral procession to Cemetery
- Delivery of Cremated Remains to Cemetery

Family/Pallbearers Limousine

The use of this car may include:

- Transportation of the family to the Funeral Home, Church or other location for the Funeral or Memorial Service
- Transportation of the family to the Cemetery or Crematorium

General Purpose Vehicle

This vehicle is used by our staff in making arrangements for the procurement and registration of necessary documents or any other trips that are in conjunction with services being performed by us. This is a flat rate charge for all services performed.

Mileage

A charge of \$2.35 per km (one way) applies to any of the cars listed for mileage incurred beyond a 20km radius of the Funeral Home. In line with the Ontario Coroner's transportation rates.

Reception Centre (& Host/Hostess)

This charge covers the use of our Reception Centre located on site, and also includes a hostess to oversee the function.

Stationery Package

Includes your choice of scenic themes. Comes with Book, 50 Thank You Cards, and 100 Memorial Cards. Individual Items: Register Book \$75.00, Memorial Cards \$2.00 per card (Minimum Order 40 Cards)

Environmental & Sanitation Fee

This charge covers the disposal of materials received from hospitals such as hazardous waste, sharps, etc, to be completed with increased sanitation requirements.

Cash Disbursements

Items paid by the family might include any of the following:

- Burial rights at a Cemetery (*prices vary depending on Cemetery*)
- Opening and closing of grave (*prices vary depending on Cemetery*)
- Cremation Charge from Quinte Funeral Crematorium is **\$750.00 (Adult Cremation)**
- Death Notices in newspapers (*prices vary depending on the newspaper*)
- Flowers (*prices vary*)
- Clergy Honorarium ranges from **\$200.00 - \$350.00**
- Organist fees are approximately **\$100.00 - \$250.00**
- Soloist fees are approximately **\$100.00**
- Church Stipend ranges from **\$25.00 to \$350.00** (*depending on the church*)
- Charges incurred at other Funeral Homes
- Transportation fees (*air or rail*)
- Winter storage vault fee (*prices vary depending on vault*)

Items paid by us on your behalf and appearing on our account as disbursements might include one of the following:

- Coroner's fees is **\$75.00** and applied only in the case of cremation or when transporting out of the province
- Registration Fee of **\$10.00** (*Belleville*), **\$12.00** (*Quinte West*), **\$10.00** (*Brighton*), **\$10.00** (*Stirling-Rawdon*) and **\$15.00** (*Picton*) for those whose death occurs out of town

Payment

Payment in full is due upon signing the contract unless otherwise noted. Payment may be made by cash, cheque, debit, and most major credit cards are accepted. Amounts outstanding after the Contract Date will bear interest at the rate of **2%** which is equivalent to **24%** per annum (APR). There will be a charge of \$40.00 for any non-sufficient (NSF) cheques returned by the bank.

Insurance Funding

We offer pre-need insurance policies designed to cover the expenses of a funeral. By enrolling in one of our policies, you can spare your family members from the stress of making complicated decisions during an already difficult time. This plan is designed to grow in value over time. If there are any excess funds at the time of death, they can be used for unanticipated expenses, or directed to a named beneficiary of choice. Rushnell Family Services has partnered with Assurant Life of Canada.

URN VAULTS

An urn vault is a container that is mainly made of composite, metal or concrete materials. It encloses and urn or cremation items to help prevent a grave from sinking in. Often the weight of earth on top of the urn, or the passage of heavy cemetery maintenance equipment over it, will cause damage or degradation to the

CASKET VAULTS

A burial vault (also known as a burial liner, grave vault, and grave liner) is a container, formerly made of wood or brick but more often today made of metal or concrete, that encloses a casket to help prevent a grave from sinking. Wooden coffins (or caskets) decompose, and often the weight of earth on top of the coffin, or the passage of heavy cemetery maintenance equipment over it, can cause the casket to collapse and the soil above it to settle.

OTHER AVAILABLE SERVICES & EQUIPMENT

Funeral Director Services (Casket) - \$375.00

This fee is for our staff member to attend a graveside or memorial service. Their duties in general would be to set up chairs and flowers, provide a lectern for a memorial book, and help facilitate or organize the service be that may be private or public.

Funeral Director Services (Cremated Remains) - \$225.00

This fee is for our staff member to attend a graveside service. Their duties would be to help in the assistance in the interment of your loved ones cremated remains.

Pallbearer Services - \$75.00 per pallbearer

This fee is for our staff member(s) to assist in the duty of a pallbearer. Their duties would be to help carry the casket from the funeral home or service location to the funeral vehicle and carry the casket from the funeral vehicle to the cemetery grave location.

Transfers (Out of Town Removals)

These fees that follow are only used when a death occurs out of our jurisdiction.

Belleville/Trenton/Brighton/Stirling/Picton (Local removal)	\$350.00

Note: Additional fees may be incurred and will be reflected on depending on the circumstance and requirements necessary in regards to the transfer of the deceased into our care.

Vault Surcharge - \$150.00 (Saturday after 12 noon ONLY)

An additional \$150.00 will be applied to vault prices if a burial takes place after 12noon on Saturdays.

Winter Storage - \$250.00

When a cemetery will not bury during the winter months, storage in a verified and legislatively compliant facility for human remains may be necessary until a spring burial is able to take place.

Refundable Deposit for Cremated Remains - \$350.00

When human remains are to be cremated, a refundable deposit will be required to be paid. If the cremated remains are not claimed within one (1) year from the date of cremation, the deposit may be used to inter the remains in common ground at a cemetery of the funeral home’s choice. If the cremated remains are claimed before they are interred, the deposit will be refunded.

Professional Restorative Procedures - \$50.00 per hour

In some circumstances, additional restorative efforts over and above those completed in the standard embalming procedure are necessary to enhance the appearance of the deceased. In such cases, the funeral director will discuss the available options and the associated costs. Professional restorative procedures will be charged per hour.

Unless otherwise identified, all prices do not include applicable taxes.

Archived Proof of Death Certificates - \$25.00/5 copies

When a family, Lawyers office, or other party requires a Proof of Death certificate 10 years or older beyond the date of death.

Scattering of Cremated Remains - \$175.00

The funeral home will scatter cremated remains in accordance with Ontario and municipal laws and also the bylaws on land. Fees for scattering from an aircraft or a water vehicle will be in addition to this charge and will be discussed upon request.

Body Shroud/Pouch - \$100.00

Use of Body Shroud/Pouch to contain the deceased when being placed in a cremation container or casket when embalming is not selected and/or not authorized.

Urn/Infant Lowering Device

Cemetery equipment and grave dressing with a tent for urns/infant cases. Local Charges \$195.00 (ie. from Brighton East to Shannonville) and \$240.00 outside the designated areas.

Grave Dressing - \$595.00

All necessary planking, artificial grass, and mechanized lowering device.

Delivery of Items - \$125.00 (additional fees beyond 20 kms of \$2.35/km)

Climate Controlled Holding Facility - \$100.00/day

- Required if there is a delay in arrangements beyond 3 days.
