Articulate humility as a strength in leadership

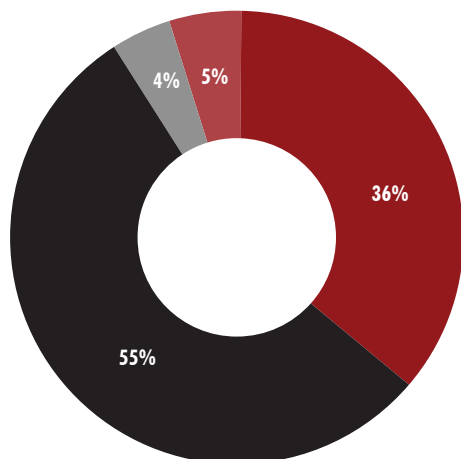
