St. Zephyrinus, Pray For Us . . .

Ever wonder about the patron saints for whom our two churches are named? When I first got here, I had the devil of a time trying to figure who the heck St. Zepherin was! I finally traced him to his Latin name, Zephyrinus: the fifteenth pope. The founders of our church, when they established the parish of St. Zepherin, were French-Canadian shoemakers, so in christening the parish they used the French variation of the name.

Most of what we know about Pope Zephyrinus is unflattering, because it comes from a source who was contemptuous of him. He was accused of being weakwilled and even more weak-minded. However, these detractions were leveled against him by a firebrand of a priest: Hippolytus would later challenge Zephyrinus's successor as bishop of Rome and become the Church's first anti-pope. (He eventually repented, was reconciled with the mainline Church, and subsequently has been canonized a saint, so there is a happy ending to the story.)

The criticism was motivated by Zephyrinus's apparent timidity when it came to denouncing some heresies. His predecessor, Pope Victor, had excommunicated the followers of a certain Theodotus of Byzantine. These folks believed that Jesus was just a plain ol' human being until the Holy Spirit had descended on Him when He was baptized by John in the Jordan River. In other words, Jesus wasn't the begotten Son of God, and that the Father alone was truly God. Even after their excommunication, though, this group maintained their position; they started their own religious community and persuaded a man named Natalis to lead them. However, Natalis began having unsettling dreams, and eventually forfeited his role; he approached Zephyrinus and threw himself at the pope's feet, begging forgiveness and readmittance to the apostolic Church.

I think this experience is key to understanding why Zephyrinus didn't come down like a ton of bricks on the next heresy to flare up during his pontificate. This time, the buzz was that Jesus wasn't just a man who was taken possession of by the Holy Spirit; now the new version was that Christ was simply another way that the one God presented Himself. It was kind of like the same person taking on the identity of Clark Kent at one time, and then Superman at other times.

Hippolytus fiercely defended the uniqueness of the Son, the Word of God who became man, even though there were some wrinkles in his particular explanation of the mystery of the Incarnation. Pope Zephyrinus, for his part, maintained very simply that there was one God, Jesus was God, and that it was the Son, not the Father, who took on flesh and was crucified. This wasn't strong enough for Hippolytus, and he denounced the pope for being too weak in his stand on the truth. Zephyrinus, however, may just have been trying to keep the matter from becoming a full-blown schism, trusting that the truth would win out in due time, as it had done earlier in the case of Natalis.

And this is pretty much all we know about St. Zephyrinus. But the threadbare sketch we have of his character, his personality, and his papacy is incredibly important. His refusal to create a major brouhaha out of the heresy shows the modest discretion that the pope historically is meant to display. As much as the Roman Catholic Church is depicted in the public eye as being authoritarian, the fact is, the magisterium (the pope and bishops) tends not to interfere in a controversy unless/until it becomes so significant as to threaten to break the communion of the Faithful. Otherwise, it's more prudent to let sleeping dogs lie, to recognize that the mystery of our Faith sometimes skirts precise definitions. St. Zepherin's papacy reminds us that insisting on minutely detailed explanations can sometimes drain the mystery out of our religion, leaving only a sterile, intellectual philosophy in place of what should be a lively faith in the personal God.

HOSPITALITY 101

Hospitality to a stranger, an unrecognized deity, and the surprise reward is common in folktales. Abraham resting in mid-day heat spots three travelers and springs into action. Not simple relief measures. He provides banquet style treatment: washing feet, rest in the shade while his household is prepping a banquet style meal even though Abraham says, "let me bring you a little food" (Gen 18:1-10a). It is God to whom this grand hospitality is being offered. Its miraculous reward: Abraham and Sarah will have the son that God has promised. (Our Lectionary omits Sarah's response – laughing at that picture of a couple in their 90s having a child, vv. 10b-15).

God chides her for that but does not cancel his promise. In the story of Martha and Mary (Lk 10:38-42), such Abraham style of hospitality could be why Martha is "burdened with much serving." After all, Jesus is not a solo traveler. He has 12 young men in tow. Unlike Abraham who parcels out tasks to servants and Sarah, Martha only has her sister. When Jesus sent disciples on mission, the instruction "eat what they set before you" (Lk 10:8) could limit any excessive displays of hospitality.

Jesus and entourage are to travel on the everyday rations of villagers, not special foods for a feast like the choice beef, bread of fine flour, and the curds of goat milk in Abraham's tent. At the Last Supper Jesus will remind his disciples, "I am among you as one who serves," (Lk 22:27). Mary has recognized that Jesus had not come into their house exhausted from the hardships of hiking the route south toward Jerusalem. He is there proclaiming that God's Kingdom is at hand. So, likes students before a teacher she settled at his feet, determined not to miss a word. What did Martha do when Jesus refused to push Mary into hospitality mode? "Throw the dish towel in his face," a member of our Bible study once said. But perhaps she cut the prep to join her sister.






