## ***St. Ann, Pray For Us . . .***

This past Friday we celebrated the feast of our *other* patron saint—or, to be more precise: half the feast day was for St. Ann; she shares it with her husband, St. Joachim. These are the grandparents of our Lord, the parents of the Virgin Mary.

You won't find any mention of them in the Bible, so don't bother looking. The names of this couple come to us from an ancient fable, known as the Protoevangelium of James—sort of a “pre-gospel.” The general consensus is that the text was written around 145 AD, and tells the story of the Virgin Mary's birth, childhood, marriage to Joseph, and the childhoods of Jesus and John the Baptist. It clearly belongs to folklore, rather than sacred literature, and much of the plot-details echo biblical stories in a fashion that seems to intentionally borrow from the authority of Scripture. To be blunt, it seems as though the author ripped off the Bible in telling his story. (For instance, there's an incident toward the end of the tale when the child John the Baptist is lost and his father Zechariah goes looking for him that clearly is meant to remind the reader of the episode in Luke's Gospel when the child Jesus gets left behind at the Temple in Jerusalem while his parents frantically look for Him.) (If there were copyright laws back then, Luke would have had an airtight plagiarism lawsuit against the cat who wrote the Protoevangelium.)

Ann's story, and Joachim's, opens the Protoevangelium. It follows a familiar pattern from the Old Testament—one also shared by John the Baptist's parents. Although very wealthy, Joachim is childless and so is rejected from making an offering in the Temple (although nothing in Jewish custom actually prohibits his sacrifice). Grieved by this, he goes off to the desert for forty days and forty nights of fasting (sound familiar?).

Ann, in the meanwhile goes into double mourning: for her “widowhood” (apparently thinking Joachim either is dead or has abandoned her; the text doesn't say which), and for her childlessness. She goes off and sits beneath a laurel tree, prays for God to bless her with a child as He did the matriarch Sarah in Genesis, and vows to bring the child up to revere God deeply if He grants her petition. She goes on to reflect on how far her state-in-life is below the other natural elements of creation because she has not been able to generate life. The passage has shades of the Old-Testament prophet Samuel's birth story, when his mother Hannah made the same prayer and proposed a similar promise to bring the child up to be holy.

Ann is still thinking about her lowly plight when an angel suddenly appears to her, and consoles her with the promise that she indeed will bear a child who is destined for worldwide fame. The same angel appears to Joachim in the desert, assures him that his prayer for a child also has been heard, and tells him to go back to his wife. Again: this hearkens back to the promise made to Abraham and Sarah that they would have a son, as well as the prophecy made to Samson's parents that they would be blessed with a child.

When Mary is born and Ann is informed the child is a girl, she offers a Readers-Digest condensed version of the Magnificat. After Mary turns three, Ann and Joachim go to present her to the Temple. A priest receives the little girl, kisses and blesses her, and utters a prophecy over her—all reminiscent of Luke's Gospel, when Jesus's parents present Him at the Temple and the prophet Simeon catches Him up and blesses Him.

Ann and Joachim pretty much fade into the background from this point in the tale on. But the Protoevangelium importantly reminds us that there isn't a break in the story of salvation history until the Blessed Mother shows up. She, and Jesus, are part of an unbroken line of God working through the people of Israel to redeem the world from sin and re-claim it for His Kingdom. The motif of sterility that runs through Ann and Joachim's story, along with the sadness that they both feel over the bleakness of their fates, is an apt symbol of the futility of the world's fate had we not been given the Savior to open eternal life to us. And the joy of fecundity, of new life being gratuitously offered through the gift of God, likewise symbolizes the joy of the new life of grace that is ours through coming to know Christ our Lord.

In the tradition of sacred art, St. Ann is depicted as instructing the child Mary in the Ten Commandments; the statues outside our church and in the basement both depict this. It reminds us that holiness and the life of grace come from learning God's commandments and being faithful to His covenant. The more we steep ourselves in the Word of God the more perfectly we become bearers of Christ in our world today. And by sharing this Word with others, we expand the reach of God's grace in this world.

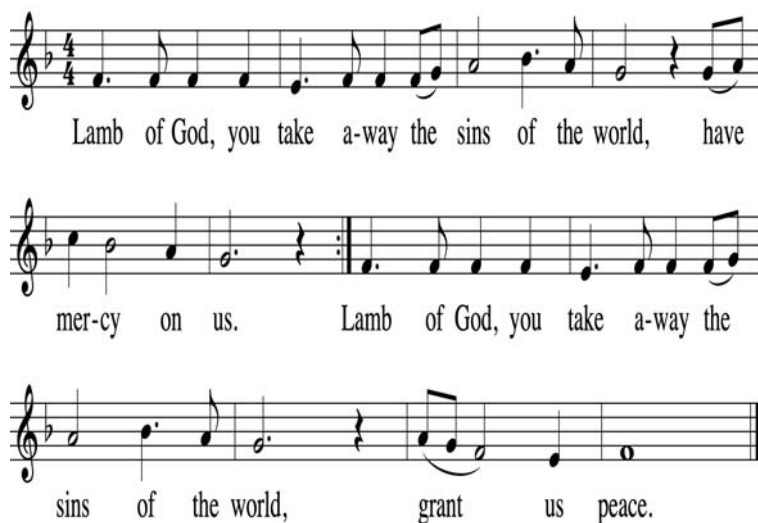

## TO SAVE A CITY

As a kid I enjoyed watching my uncle auction cows. As an adult bargaining in a Jerusalem or Cairo marketplace was torture. "They will be disappointed if you don't bargain," a Dominican friend from the Ecole Biblique explained. So, I would gather prices from high end shops that took American Express and head for the souk. At 33% off that figure, I would agree to the price. Seemed fair to me and always worked. In today's reading from Genesis 18:20-32 Abraham and God are bargaining over the fate of Sodom and Gomorrah. Everyone knew that dry, devastated landscape near the Dead Sea as the example of divine punishment.

Yet God decides to let Abraham in on the operation. And what does Abraham do? He starts to bargain. After all disasters kill people not responsible for evil-doing in the city. The translation "innocent people" might make us think of those elderly, women, and children being killed by air strikes every day in Gaza or Ukraine. But the Hebrew word asks about adult males who are "just, upright, devout", that is devoted to actively living as God intends. People who will establish justice in judging rightly. So, the question is how many such people would a city need to be spared?

God agrees to spare the cities for as few as little as ten righteous people. Centuries later when leaders in Jerusalem remained deaf to the prophet Jeremiah's calls for justice, God makes an even more generous offer, "...search...to find **just one** who acts justly and seeks honesty, and I will pardon her" (Jer 5:1). Whether it is 10 or just 1 a city can be rescued from destruction by the few committed to justice and truth. Perhaps it seems hard to spot them in the noisy market place. Yet every adult could represent that one who saves the city. Luke's version of the Lord's Prayer suggests how, "...for we ourselves forgive everyone in debt to us," (Lk 11:4).

### Help Wanted! Family Promise Metrowest Overnight Shelter Volunteers

Family Promise has several openings for overnight **volunteers** at our shelter this summer. These volunteers fulfill a critical role in the organization, ensuring support for guests in the event of an emergency. Although the shift is typically quiet, the comforting presence of an overnight volunteer in the absence of our Residential Support Specialist is a gift to both families and our staff. You will stay in the private apartment above the FPM shelter where you have access to a full private bath, kitchen, and a full-sized futon for sleeping. While you are free to interact with the families in common areas after your initial check-in with them, they typically have small children and tend to retire early. You are expected to do nothing more than be present in the apartment and get a good night's sleep. You will know who is living in the shelter at the time, and you will have a contact number in the rare case of an emergency.

Each shift is 8:30pm - 8:30am but negotiable in the event you need an earlier start for work/family commitments in the morning. Eligible volunteers are 18+ years old, submit to a background check in advance of serving, and must have completed our online volunteer orientation through our website.



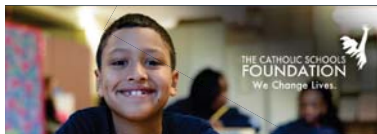
