#### The Church's Gospel . . .

For the longest time, the Church only selected from Matthew's Gospel for the passages to be read at Mass. Since the Second Vatican Council, though, the readings rotate on a cycle of three years, alternating among Mark, Luke, and Matthew. This new liturgical year, which begins next week, we focus once more on Matthew. Nonetheless, because of this long history of emphasizing Matthew, the Book has been called the Church's Gospel. However, we could call Matthew the Church's Gospel for another, more significant reason: the author's concern throughout the text is to chart the establishment of the Church.

In her essence, the Church is fundamentally a community: a gathering of people united by faith in, and devotion to, the God Who saves us. And the Gospel of Matthew, more than the other three biblical accounts of Jesus's life, emphasizes this newly formed community that is the Church.

But this isn't just any ol' community, a clique pretty much like any other group. It's a community that finds its special character in its relationship to God. From the very onset of the Gospel, Matthew makes it clear that his concern will be with the forging of relationships shaped by God's own Hand. He opens up with a detailed genealogy drawing lines of connection down through the ages that link Jesus to Abraham through David. The community of believers even stretches back through history. And Matthew's motif of signaling how Jesus is the fulfillment of prophecies from the Hebrew Scriptures continually underscores these deep historical roots of the Church.

Throughout the Gospel, Matthew chronicles Jesus's building of the Church. In the tenth chapter, He forms the apostles and sends them out on mission, establishing the central purpose of this community: proclaiming the gospel, announcing the coming of the Kingdom, healing and forgiving. They are to enter a house in every town and stay in that house. In other words, they are to establish an abiding community. And when that community is stable, to go and found other communities rooted in the same identity of the gospel proclamation.

In chapter eighteen, Jesus lays out the order of the Church. Each believer is to bear responsibility for every other believer, gently calling them to repentance and growth in holiness. If one-on-one

persuasion doesn't work, then a handful of believers should be brought along for an "intervention." If that fails to make the right impact, then appeal to the authority of the Church to step in and restore order.

Jesus Himself is presented as the chief pastor of the Church. His ministry is one of healing and forgiving sins, the same mission He entrusts to the apostles partway through the gospel. And His ministry is punctuated by a series of sermons—most famously, the Sermon on the Mount. Preaching and administering healing grace forms the pattern of His life, a pattern that the disciples continue after Him and that's extended down through the ages by the Church He founded.

In short, the sum total of Matthew's Gospel is found in Christ's abiding presence to His Church. The Gospel begins with an angel telling Joseph that he is to name Mary's child Emmanuel, which means "God is with us." It closes with Jesus assuring the apostles "behold, I am with you always, even till the end of the ages." The Church stretches back into the history of Israel as God's People and reaches forward to span all subsequent epochs to the end of time. Christ remains as God's presence with us—initially, in person during the Incarnation, but also in the Word proclaimed to us and the sacraments that bring us mysteriously into communion with the Risen Lord. These forge the identity of the Church: the remembrance of His earthly life that give the Church her heritage, and the ongoing faith in Christ's Resurrection that grounds our present hope for the future. They comprise our ongoing mission, and they are the cords that bind us together into a community that follow Christ our Lord, proclaiming that Christ has died, Christ is risen, and Christ will come again.



#### **BEYOND BATTLE**

"The American Revolution is the second most important event in human history after the birth of Jesus," was a Ken Burns tag line for his PBS documentary on the American Revolution. Some lively debate occurred about that #2 ranking, but only theologians protested the Christmas tree influence. Today's readings from Paul (Col 1:12-20) and Luke (23:35-43) show that Scripture does not claim "birth of Jesus" but his "death and resurrection" that is critical for the human story. An interviewer who said that before seeing the film she had no idea of how the vicious battles could apply that to the story of Jesus' execution. Nail the bloodied criminals up in public for a slow, excruciating death as lungs collapse along with verbal taunts from by-standers was routine procedure.

In the gospel a man crucified alongside Jesus adopts such verbal hostility against him for not being a warrior messiah like David. After winning a brutal civil war, king David created a new Israel from divided tribes (2 Sam 5:1-3). His words shock a fellow criminal into surprising behavior. Instead of adding to the chorus, he acknowledges their guilt and Jesus' innocence. Somehow this despised figure dying between them has salvation to offer. When he expressed that emerging faith in the prayer, "Jesus, remember me", did he imagine the response, "today with me in paradise"? How did the first man react? Repeated scorn? Recognition of missed opportunity? Attempt to get in too?

Is the confederacy of tribes who acknowledge that David as God's chosen ruler the way to peace beyond battle? It doesn't endure. Yet it's the hope for God's people expressed by those who mocked the Christian gospel about a crucified savior raised with power over the whole cosmos (Col 1:17-20). Reconciliation of those estranged whether as humans or humans from God is not a victor's gift to the conquered. Instead, the sacrificial death of God's Son opens the way to a kingdom not won in the blood of battle. Rejecting the boastful taunts directed at the weak, pray with the second man, "Jesus, remember me..."


