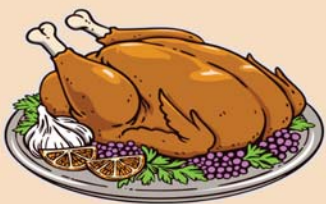
Congratulations!

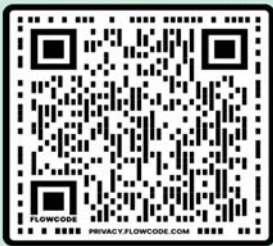

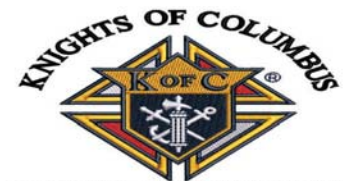

GOD SHALL JUDGE

How many nations are torn by violence this Advent? Beyond the news from Gaza, Bethlehem without pilgrims and Ukraine, add Sudan, kidnapping of Catholic school girls in Nigeria, vicious gang take-over in Haiti's capital, drug gangs in Ecuador and other countries ... and that's just the list from friends, colleagues, or students. The world wasn't less war torn in Isaiah's 8th century BCE or the 1st century CE of Jesus. But the technology of war magnifies the possibilities of destruction. A Vietnam nurse described a furious rage at seeing bodies blown apart by IUDs. Not like her worst ER cases stateside. Those, at least, have a reason in what people did to each other.

Isaiah imagines a time when all nations in the world come streaming to Jerusalem – hardly a major world capital in the 8th cent. (or ours). And the “peace terms” are not being imposed by super-power an emperor deciding disputes between subject principalities. Instead, God sets conditions for world peace, limiting arsenals, alliances or the size of armies but complete disarmament. *“They shall beat their swords into plowshares and their spears into pruning hooks...nor shall they train for war again,”* (Isa 2:4).

Where are the human rulers who can execute God's vision of justice? Not those in Judah who enriched themselves at the expense of the poor (Isa 1:21-28). Instead, the prophet imagines a new king from David's lineage to come radiating that justice and truth in a new creation (Isa 11:3-10). Those hopes for a “messiah” remained alive in Jesus' day. Even though the day of God's judgment that will bring this world of warfare to an end remains deferred to an unknown figure, Jesus as messiah enabled a new vision. St. Paul encourages believers to wake up from sleep and “put on the armor of light ... the Lord Jesus Christ, and make no provisions for the desires of the flesh,” (Rom 13:14). God has a people to “walk in the light of the Lord” as Isaiah hoped (Isa 2:5).

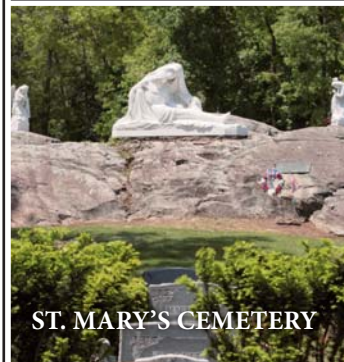
