

Chalking the Door

The traditional date of Epiphany is January 6, but in the United States it is celebrated on the Sunday between January 2 and January 8.

It is a long-held Catholic tradition to bless one's home on (or near) the celebration of the Epiphany by using chalk to write a special inscription above the home's entrance. If your parish does not have blessed chalk for you, then you can bless chalk at home yourself!

The inscription written over the door changes every year. For this year, you should write "20 + C + M + B + 26."

The letters C, M, and B have two meanings. They are the initials of the traditional names of the three magi: Caspar, Melchior, and Balthazar. They are also the first letters of the Latin words *Christus mansionem benedicat*, "May Christ bless the house." The + signs represent the cross, and 2026 is the year.

Below is a very family-friendly Epiphany home blessing.

Blessing the Chalk

Priest/adult: Our help is in the name of the Lord: All: The maker of heaven and earth.

Priest/adult: The Lords shall watch over your going out and your coming in:

All: From this time forth for evermore.

Priest/adult: The Lord be with you.

All: And also with you. Priest/adult: Let us pray.

All: Loving God, bless this chalk which you have created, that it may be helpful to your people; and grant that through the invocation of your most Holy Name all who use it in faith to write upon the door of their homes the names of your saints, Caspar, Melchior, and Balthazar, may receive health of body and protection of soul for all who dwell in or visit their home; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

(You may sprinkle the chalk with holy water.)

Instructions for Blessing the Home

Optional Scripture Reading: Matthew 2:1—16

Also optional: you can sprinkle holy water in each room of your house while singing hymns or praying the rosary. Then gather at the front door of your home.

Using the blessed chalk, mark the lintel of your front door (or porch step, or a wall within your home) as follows:

20 + C + M + B + 26


Saying:

The three Wise Men, Caspar, Melchior, and Balthazar, followed the star of God's Son who became human two thousand and twenty-five years ago. May Christ bless our home and remain with us throughout the new year. Amen.

The say the following prayer:

Visit, O blessed Lord, this home with the gladness of your presence. Bless all who live or visit here with the gift of your love; and grant that we may manifest your love to each other and to all whose lives we touch. May we grow in grace and in the knowledge and love of you: guide, comfort, and strengthen us in peace, O Jesus Christ, now and for ever. Amen.






GOD'S DIPLOMATS?

Centuries of Christian artistic imagination embellished Matthew's story of mysterious figures from the east of Rome's imperial boundaries who came looking for the baby who would be a world ruler from Jerusalem/Judah (Matt 2:1-12). Skilled at interpreting unusual signs in the heavens, they might observe a comet, a supernova, or unusual alignment of Jupiter and Saturn that others did not. So, they assumed that the future king would be found in Jerusalem's royal palaces. Everyone in Syrian Antioch ca. 90 CE when Matthew told the story knew of Rome's disastrous wars attempting to push its borders across the Euphrates, Rome's destruction of Jerusalem in putting down the Jewish rebellion in 70 CE, and that Herod, the Great (d. 4 BCE), owed the throne to an alliance with Caesar.

Whether the magi had come from Arabia (aromatic spices), Persia (gold, prostration before kings), or Babylon (astronomical records, prophecies), diplomatic protocol required that authorization from their rulers. The star-sign is not a GPS. Foreigners could not have knowledge of Israel's prophecies about a king to emerge from the house of David. Or that Herod lacked those genes! No wonder that "...he was greatly troubled and all Jerusalem with him." The fine-tuned peace within Rome's borders would be shattered in a generation. Were foreign kings hoping to be on the winner's side in capturing Roman territory?

Herod lies about his intentions, hoping for information to eliminate a threat to his succession. Since in Matthew's gospel the magi symbolically fulfil prophecies about the nations coming to worship Israel's God with such gifts (Isa 60:1-6; Ps 72:10-11), they cannot return home without doing so. And diplomats travelling with the "wealth of nations" aren't invisible in a small town like Bethlehem. Our Epiphany pageant could have had the kings' retinue tailed by the inevitable gaggle of noisy kids pointing at the strangers. What did God's diplomacy accomplish? Jesus will have to reprise a Jewish history of flight into and return from Egypt – not to Jerusalem but Nazareth. Hardly a "world-ruler" like Caesar Augustus.
