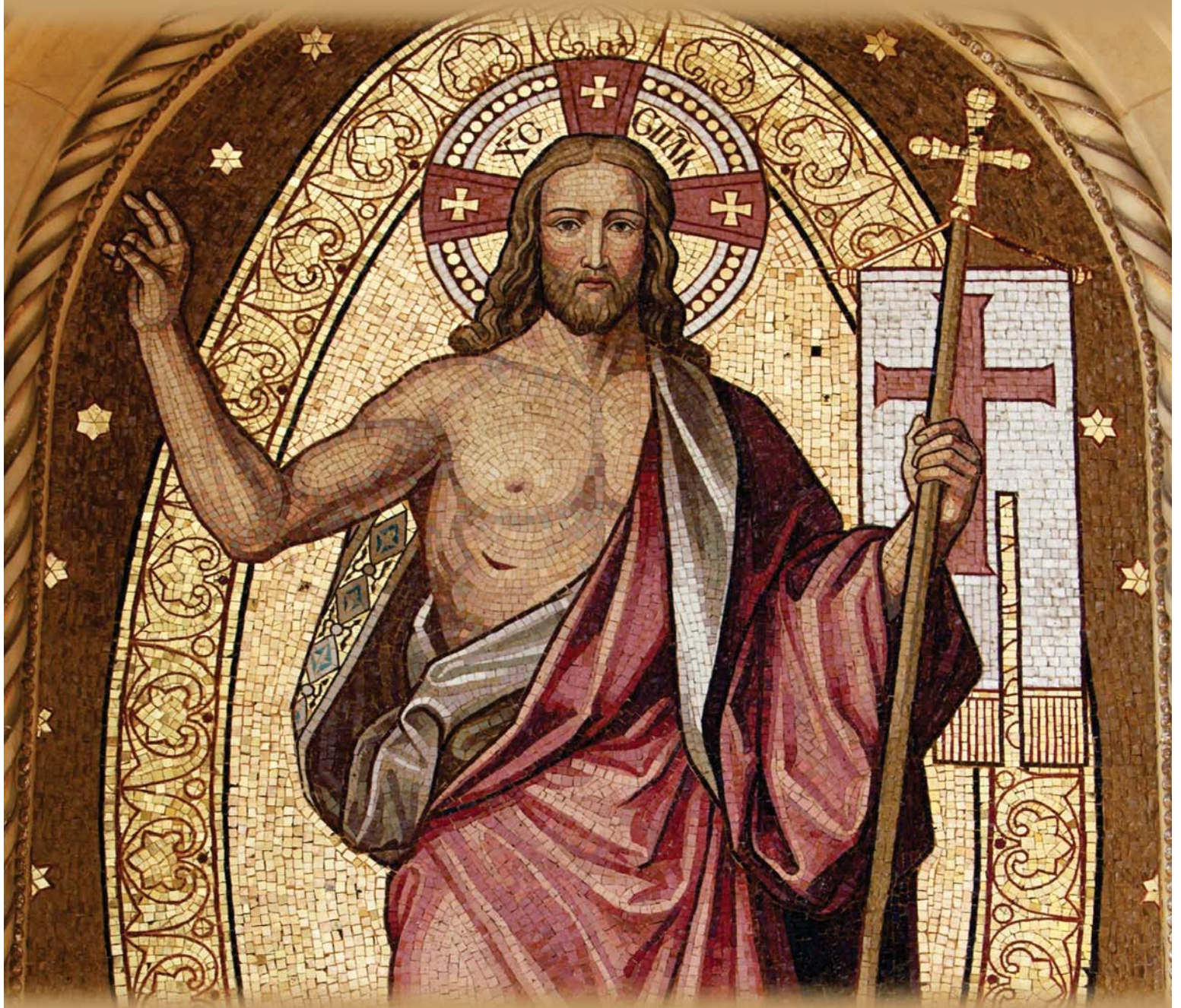

What is Easter?

The Easter Vigil is the “Mother of All Vigils.” Easter Sunday, then, is the greatest of all Sundays, and Easter Time is the most important of all liturgical times. Easter is the celebration of the Lord’s Resurrection from the dead, culminating in his Ascension to the Father and sending of the Holy Spirit upon the Church. There are 50 days of Easter from the first Sunday of Easter to Pentecost. It is characterized, above all, by the joy of glorified life and the victory over death, expressed most fully in the great resounding cry of the Christian, Alleluia! All faith flows from faith in the Resurrection: “If Christ has not been raised, then empty [too] is our preaching; empty, too, is your faith” (1 Cor 15:14).

“What you sow is not brought to life unless it dies. And what you sow is not the body that is to be but a bare kernel of wheat, perhaps, or of some other kind; . . . So also is the resurrection of the dead. It is sown corruptible; it is raised incorruptible. It is sown dishonorable; it is raised glorious. It is sown weak; it is raised powerful. It is sown a natural body; it is raised a spiritual body. If there is a natural body, there is also a spiritual one. So, too, it is written, ‘The first man, Adam, became a living being,’ the last Adam a life-giving spirit. But the spiritual was not first; rather the natural and then the spiritual. The first man was from the earth, earthly; the second man, from heaven. As was the earthly one, so also are the earthly, and as is the heavenly one, so also are the heavenly. Just as we have borne the image of the earthly one, we shall also bear the image of the heavenly one” (1 Cor 15:36-37, 42-49).

The Octave of Easter comprises the eight days, which stretch from the first Sunday of Easter to the Second Sunday of Easter. It is a way of prolonging the joy of the initial day. In a sense, every day of the Octave is like a little Sunday.

The word “Easter” comes from Old English, meaning simply the “east.” The sun that rises in the east, bringing light, warmth, and hope, is a symbol for the Christian of the rising Christ, who is the true Light of the world. The Paschal Candle is a central symbol of this divine light, which is Christ. It is kept near the ambo throughout Easter Time and is lit for all liturgical celebrations.

LIFE FROM ABOVE

Ask an astronomer “where is life from?”, you might get a story of asteroids seeding early earth with necessary chemical components or searching for exoplanets with theme as life evolved elsewhere. Ask a plant biologist and you might find the story in this month’s *Scientific American* about how the “Corpse Plant” evolved its “dead flesh” smell to attract the insects that spread its seeds (April, 2026, pp. 50-57). Whether in the vast reaches of space or the micro-details of genes, evolutionary change, and the web of living things, all individuals die. Minus the science, that is what the early Israelites thought. God sentenced humanity to death for disobedience, “...out of dust you were taken, to dust you shall return” (Gen 3:19b).

The Hebrew Bible does not imagine humans as immortal souls that temporarily lived in bodies. Our feelings, ideas, thinking are connected with the heart. By Jesus’ day as Jews lived through exile, subjection to various empires, and martyrs who died for God and Torah rather than worship false gods, developed a new belief. The tomb would not be the end. God had a new creative act in mind. At the end of this world God would call the dead back from their graves.

For the faithful, righteous there would be a new mode of existence like angels or stars, “...shall shine like the stars forever and ever,” (Dan 12:3). Pharisees believed in resurrection, so did Jesus. But that belief had no space for a “resurrection biology” that would be part of the dust to dust world in which we all still live two millennia later. The gospels preserve stories about finding Jesus’ body missing which made no more sense in their world than in today’s science.

Only other experiences with Jesus, both “body” as the real self and not like our “dust”, persuaded them that Jesus lives with God in heaven. That is where the true life for all believers is, “...your life is hidden with Christ in God,” (Col 3:3).

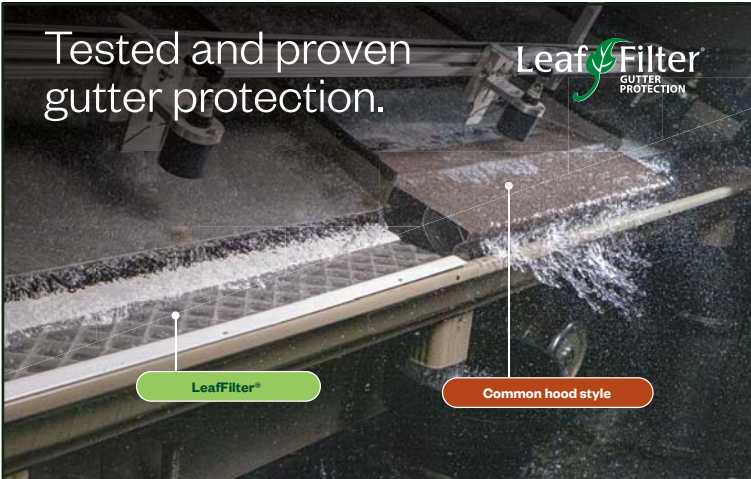

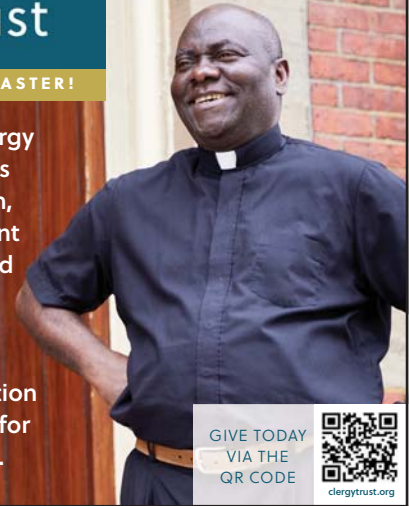

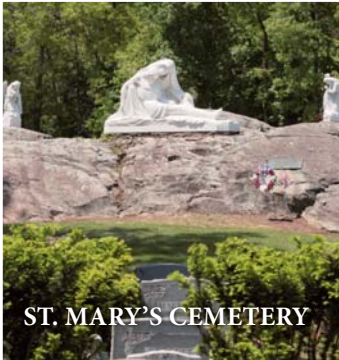
